POLICE NOTICE

All motorists are informed that Traffic Lights have been installed at the Broad Street, Oduami Street crossing and will shortly be in operation.

The following instructions regarding the lights should be strictly adhered to:-

- When the light is,
 - RED ——— it means STOP and wait behind the stop line on the roadway.
 - RED AND AMBER ——— means STOP but be prepared to go when the GREEN shows.
 - GREEN ——— means GO if the road is clear but with particular care if the intention is to turn right or left.
 - AMBER ——— means STOP at the stop-line unless the AMBER signal appears when you have already passed the top-line or are so close to it that to pull up might cause an accident.

Cooperation of all road users is earnestly requested in this matter in the interests of Road Safety and the avoidance of accidents.

Re-Assembly Of The House Of Representatives

AUGUST, 1954

It is notified for general information that the House of Representatives will reassemble in the Chamber of the House of Representatives in Lagos at 10 a.m. on Friday the 13th of August, 1954.

ADMISSION OF THE PUBLIC TO THE MEMBERS' GALLERY

- (a) Admission to the Members' Gallery will be by ticket only and is free.
- (b) Except on the opening day, tickets will be obtainable from Members of the House after they appear up to two points per sitting (morning and afternoon) each day of the meeting if seats are available.
- (c) Holders of Members' Gallery tickets must occupy their seats by 10.30 a.m. and 3.30 p.m. in respect of the morning and afternoon sittings respectively on Mondays to Thursdays, and by 9.30 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays, after which time tickets will be issued for any seats remaining vacant in strict rotation to members of the public who queue at the Maxwell Street entrance to the building. All tickets issued for the Members' Gallery must be shown to the usher when the holder goes to his seat.
- (d) Holders of Members' Gallery tickets for the opening day must occupy their seats by 9.30 a.m. At that time the doors will be closed and there will be no further admission to the Members' Gallery until after the commencement of the sittings.
- (e) Visitors are admitted to the Members' Gallery of the House of Representatives only on the understanding that they will maintain order and decorum.
- (f) No fee is payable for Members' Gallery tickets.

ADMISSION TO THE OFFICE BLOCK OF THE HOUSE

Admission of members of the public to the Office Block of the House during meetings will be by pass only. As the Maxwell Street entrance to the building, Members of the public not in possession of a pass and having a special interest for admission to the Office Block may apply to the Reception Office at the Maxwell Street entrance, or to the Secretary to the Clerk of the House of Representatives, Telephone 2072, Extension 59.
