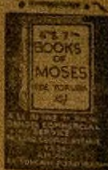

**L.E.D.B. Introduces Street  
Works Policy In Lagos**

**THE PAST**

The rate of building in Lagos during recent years has been  
very considerable, and in the opinion of the Board this rate  
will continue to increase.



A great deal of this building has  
proceeded on land where streets,  
drainage, sanitation and  
water supply are not available.

The living conditions of  
people housed under these  
conditions can rapidly become  
unsound and insanitary and  
demand of any process of public  
sanitary action.

Urban development in Lagos  
town requires careful design  
and provision of street, sewer  
drainage and road access. Other-  
wise the areas are hazardous to  
vehicles and subject to flooding  
during the heavy seasons.

Street and drainage provision  
is generally vested in  
by the public in the  
responsibility of the Lagos  
Town Council, and it is  
throughout the Town and  
partly to the past. At the  
township, the Lagos Town  
Council is carrying out a  
programme, but only under  
these able financial assistance.

The use of apparatus of  
making up to the existing  
drainage in the same manner,  
and building development must  
be controlled within this  
position.
