## The Rt. Hon. Oliver Lyttelton Secretary Of State For The Colonies Arrives At Ibadan

The Secretary of State and party landed at Ibadan at 10.15 a.m. on Monday 26th May. They were met at the aerodrome by His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, Dr. Rufus, the Civil Secretary, and the Commissioner of Police. The party then drove straight to Government Lodge where a luncheon was held with the Regional Executive Council, present at the meeting, besides the official who is the Oil of life, the Oyo of Oyo, the Odele of Ibadan the Hon. Odele of Ibadan, Minister of Local Government the Hon. C. D. Akra, Minister of Local Development, Hon. A. M. Akintoye, Minister of Agriculture, the Hon. J. E. Odujo, Minister of Lands.

At noon the Secretary of State met leading Ibadan citizens at a Cocktail Party in Government me Lodge. He said the new Constitution was just taking root and that the flower in it would be appreciated by the people of the country, and the main problem in this connection was transport. The Secretary of State observed that Nigeria looked at the right time which was a good thing.

Later the Secretary of State visited the Ibadan University where he met the Principal Dr. Mokuolu and representatives of the Staff and students in the principal's quarters. After conferring with the students' Director he was taken round by the Principal. The party saw the University library and Mr. Lyttelton expressed a high opinion of what was done by the staff and students in West Africa. The party saw the regional centre buildings of the University and the new lecture blocks.

After a luncheon with the Ministers completed the day's engagements on Monday morning, the 27th. May the Secretary of State visited Mico Plantations and later the Tobacco Company. The visit a party included Lady Mary Lyttelton, Mr. Agba, and Mr. Odujo, the Secretary of State's Private Secretary, Mr. G. Barnes, Head of the Colonial Office, Mr. W. G. Jones, and Mr. J. H. Hill of the Duty. At 2.30 pm Mr. Lyttelton and his party left the Government Lodge for the airport to Lagos.
