


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Textile Tips On Nigerian Fashions British Corporation Makes A Move

LONDON — The British National Wool Textile Corporation has been sounding the views of a group of Nigerians studying in Britain, on the subjects which kind of dress do Nigerians prefer, traditional or Western?

The questions were put in preparation for the launching of the Corporation's campaign in October to promote the sales of British wool cloth and knitting yarns in Nigeria. The campaign will open with fashion parades in Lagos and other principal cities.

A panel of Nigerians, led by Mr. Akando Dahunsi, Chief Education Officer of Lagos, who is on a practical attachment to the City of Hull, put its views to the Corporation at a special luncheon in Bradford centre of Britain's woollen industry.

To the question, "What should be the proportion of traditional costumes to Western dress?" Mr. Dahunsi replied: "People in the cities are inclining more to wearing Western dress and this is having an influence in the village. Let us see a good choice of Western dress, which is smart and comfortable, alongside on equal number of traditional garments."

Six Nigerian students all studying in the Bradford area who also served on the panel, had different

views.

Said Mr. Dipo Ogunsiire, from Ondo, an Economics student at Bradford Institute of Education: "National costume is still most popular in Northern Nigeria and the country districts. It would be better to include 70-80% of these garments in your parade."

Putting a woman's point of view, Miss Yemi Akinse, daughter of Chief Akinse of Ondo, said: "We like traditional dress but we also like Western dress."

I am sure Nigerian women would like to see African and Western fashions in equal numbers at this parades."

Other members of the panel were: Miss Celestina Enene Briggs of Enugu; Mr. Yemi Ladipo of Ibadan and Mr. Phillip Abiodun Ononeyin of Ondo—all studying at Bradford Technical College and Mr. Sunday Babatunde Onadeko a Lagos journalist.

Before the discussion, the panel visited a Yorkshire woollen mill and several orders being prepared for well-known firms in Nigeria.

African Parliamentarians In Britain

LONDON Three West African Parliamentarians from Nigeria, Sierra Leone and Gambia will hear all aspects of Parliamentary democracy discussed by experts during a month's course as guests of the General Council of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association and at the British branch of the CPA. Joining the course at Westminster from today un-

til 29th May are Mr. F.U. Mbakogu, M.P. Parliamentary Secretary to the Nigerian Federal Minister of Economic Development; the Hon. Waziri Ibrahim, M.P. the Deputy Speaker of the Sierra Leone House of Representatives; Mr. J. E. H. Tucker; and the Speaker of the Gambia House of Representatives, the Hon. A. S. Jack.

Two Nigerians Join Crop Protection Course In Britain

LONDON — Three West Africans—two Nigerians and one Ghanaian—are among 16 overseas specialists who have just begun a six months' course on crop protection in Britain.

The Nigerians taking the course at Fisons Pecto Control Ltd., under Nigeria/U.K. technical assistance arrangements, are Daniel Abi Bolarin of the Institute for Agricultural Research, Ahmadu Bello University, and Fidelis Chukwunwike Oghogwu, Assistance Agricultural Superintendent, Ministry of Agriculture, Eastern Nigeria.

The group will spend most of their time at the Company's research station near Cambridge. During the next six months they will make a detailed survey of the present principles and methods in the whole field of crop protection within Britain and in overseas countries.

The subjects covered range from pesticidal research, spraying machinery and safety precautions to weed control of rodents and insects; and the course also includes a comprehensive programme of practical visits and attachment to Government research stations, agricultural shows and leading manufacturers of agricultural machinery and pesticides.

Nigerian Sailors Train In Britain

LONDON—To gain technical knowledge vital for the future expansion of the Royal Nigerian Navy, two young Nigerian sailors are now on a nine-months course at the British naval base at Portsmouth.

They are Christopher C. Okeke, of Ute, and E. U. Egbuleebu, of Aba, and at the Royal Navy's electrical training establishment, H.M.S. "Collingwood," they are learning to use and maintain equipment on every type of ship from light patrol craft to battleships and submarines.

Okeke and Egbuleebu joined the Royal Nigerian Navy together on the same day; they trained together aboard H.M.N.S. "Nigeria," and on H.M.N.S. "Enugu." Their present course, which they are taking with sailors from the Royal Navy and other Commonwealth navies, will fit them to become Petty Officers in the Electrical Branch.

Nigeria's New Liner

LONDON—Nigeria's new cargo liner, the "Ahmadu Bello," has carried out successful sea trials off Tyneside, north-east England.

She is a sister ship to the "Nnamdi Azikiwe" and both have been built for the Nigerian National Shipping Line Ltd. by Swan Hunter and Wigham Richardson. But there is one difference—the second ship has been equipped to carry 12 passengers as well as refrigerated cargo, vegetable oil, latex and glycerine.

Following her successful trials the Ahmadu "Bello" is due to leave the Tyne for Middlesborough where she will load a part cargo of steel. After a few days stop in London she will continue her maiden voyage to West African ports.
