

YABA TECHNICAL INSTITUTE. EVENING CLASSES.

PRELIMINARY COURSES

No. 113.

An examination for admission of new students to the preliminary evening classes will be held at the Yaba Technical Institute on August 21st, 22nd and 23rd 1951. Application forms may be obtained from the Principal to whom they must be returned NOT LATER THAN JULY 31ST 1951. Completed forms received after this date will not be considered whatever the circumstances responsible for their late arrival. Completed forms must be accompanied by a Treasury Receipt for 1/-.

1. Applicants must be in possession of a Government Standard VI or a Government Secondary II pass certificate and they must not be under the age of 16 years on September 1st 1951. Applicants must be residents of Lagos area.

2. The following courses are offered:
Metalwork Carpentry and Joinery. Electrical Installation.

The nominal fee for all courses is 10/-.
3. Candidates who are selected as a result of the Entrance Examination will be required to attend at the Technical Institute during Registration week in order to complete registration and pay fees. The date of Registration Week will be announced in successful candidates.

4. A list of successful candidates in the Entrance Examination will be published in this Press.

SENIOR COURSES

1. Provided a sufficient number of qualified candidates apply it is proposed to form the 1st year class of a 3 year Senior Course in Mechanical and Electrical Engineering Students in September 1951. Subjects of the course for the 1st year will be Mathematics, Engineering Science and Engineering Drawing and workshop Practice and the associated work for the courses will be 41.

2. Applicants for these Senior Courses must be in possession of at least a Government Secondary IV pass certificate and be not above the age of 18 years on September, 1st 1951.

3. Application forms for the Senior Course may be obtained from the Principal, Yaba Technical Institute to whom they must be returned completed NOT LATER THAN JULY 31ST, 1951, and will be no entrance examination but applicants will be required to submit evidence of possession of a Government Certificate of at least Secondary IV standard.

4. First students of the Yaba Technical Institute Day Continuation Evening Classes in Mechanical Engineering and Electrical Installation will be successful in the entrance examination at the end of the second year course are eligible to apply for admission to the Senior Course.

5. The names of selected candidates will be published in the Press and these candidates will be required to attend at the Technical Institute during Registration Week in order to register and pay fees.

TECHNICAL INSTITUTE- Junior Technical Department

Applications are invited from qualified candidates for a limited number of vacancies in a 3 year residential course at the Yaba Technical Institute commencing on the 1st October, 1951. Applicants must not be over 16 years of age on 1st January 1951 and they must be in possession of either a Government Standard VI or a Government Secondary II pass certificate. Applicants will be required to submit evidence of age and educational standard.

Selection of applicants for these vacancies will be made on the result of an open competitive examination and personal interview to be held in Ibadan, Benin and Lagos on the following dates:-

- Ibadan July 18th and 20th 1951
- Benin 23rd 1951
- Lagos 30th August 1st 1951.

Fees for the course are £15 per annum payable termly at the rate of £5 per term. Fees are payable in advance and selected candidates will not be permitted to attend until the fee has been paid.

Application forms may be obtained from the Provincial Education Officers at Ibadan, Benin and Lagos. **THEY CANNOT BE OBTAINED FROM THE PRINCIPAL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE** When completed the forms must be returned to the Principal Technical Institute Yaba accompanied by a Treasury Receipt for 2/6d. **THE LAST DATE FOR THE RETURN OF COMPLETED FORMS TO THE PRINCIPAL IS THE 31ST, MAY 1951.** Forms received after this date will not be considered whatever the circumstances responsible for their late arrival. Forms received without the accompanying Treasury Receipt will not be considered. The Examination fee of 2/6d is not returnable.
