## FACTS AND FIGURES

## AN ORDER OF THE COURT.

The Mohammedan religion came to us from the North where primitive and Oriental customs prevailed. For this it is generally conceived that all Oriental and native practices are endorsed by that religion. But the fact that Islam is making headways in England, France, Germany and many other European countries as well as the United States of America is a direct negation of this idea. In these days of enlightenment when Mohammedans in Lagos begin to move rapidly forward in Occidental education and civilisation it becomes clearer than ever that Islam is as universal as Christianity and can be adapted to any custom or civilisation.

In view of the above facts it is as surprising as it is degrading to notice that in accordance with an order a present in force in the Law Courts Mohammedans are asked to take off their shoes when giving evidence. The writer was in court the other day when a youngman of this town (Mohammedan by faith) who was accustomed to European dress was engaged in a civil action. To the surprise and indignation of all present he was ordered to take off his shoes!!!

Is it against the law that the Mohammedan subjects of His Majesty the King should adopt European custom as the Christians do? What justification on earth can the authorities concerned give for this highly degrading order-in-court? Is it that the Mohammedan religion supports it or that a section of the Mohammedans are accustomed to such practice? If the latter, why then should educated Muslims be forced to obey a custom which to them is primitive and disagreeable to their mode of living? The reason, we are told, why such an order is passed is that Mohammedans are allowed to keep on their turbans in the Courts, they therefore should remove their shoes as they generally do before entering a house as a mark of respect. But this should not apply to all Muslims as turbans are not worn by all Muslims. A Mohammedan who is clad in European dress has to take off his straw hat for instance, and, for that particular individual to have to remove his shoes again baffles our understanding.

But this may not be the reason that brings about the enforcement of this order. Whatever the reason or reasons, may be it is bringing back the hands of the clock when a civilized and educated Muslim shall have to take off his shoes after taking off his hat before giving evidence in the Law Courts simply because the illiterate and primitive bulk of Mohammedans in Lagos are used to a certain custom.

However, we hope educated Muslims in Lagos will join hands together to petition the Government with a view to get the order repealed.

Ibi enia ra Ohi lati fi ranse si Kano, tabi Oroso-Epa lati Kano wa si Eko fun ita, lehin ti oluware ba yo owo to fi ra won kuro, to si yo owo oko ati owo wison kuro, eyi to ku gbese ni. Nje, kini antani *Railway* tabi olo ile ti ko se lu ni rere?
