NIGERIA AND THE NATIONAL CONGRESS.

The National Congress has decided to send delegates from the Gold Coast and Sierra Leone branches to Nigeria in December to attempt to reawaken local interest in the Congress movement. Nigeria understands the ideals of the movement, but her educated men appear to find the "applied" science of government more interesting than the "pure" variety, and prefer to recognise that the term "African racial aspirations" is a portmanteau phrase, including a range of ideals extending from representative

self-government on the one hand to simple desire to be freed from European domination to carry out more primitive customs on the other. When Nigeria has attained to a more homogeneous structure, and the opinion of a conference at Lagos may with safety be regarded as the opinion of even a quarter of the 18 million inhabitants of the Colony and Protectorate, it will be time for her to consider interesting herself in ideals which the experience of Lagos has proved are not yet practicable.

Plaintiff's statement of Claim filed on the 24th day of October, 1924, is as follows:—

1. By a Deed of Settlement dated on the 31st day of January, 1895, and made between Rufus Alexander Wright, Settlor of the one part, Emanuel Wright of the second part, Sodunde Alfred Leigh Sodippe and Defendant Kituyi Ajasa Trustees of the third part and registered as No. 91, Volume 26, at Page 356 of the Register of Deeds, Lagos. All those pieces or parcels of land situate at Ebute Metta, in the mainland of Lagos, commonly known as Wright's Farm in Wright's Town, Ebute Metta and farm-lands situate at Agege described in the Deeds of Settlement as Isheri lands, were assured unto the said Sodunde Alfred Leigh Sodippe and Kituyi Ajasa as such trustees in fee simple subject to the following trusts, viz:—

(a) To the use of the said Emanuel Wright for life.

(b) And thereafter to the use of one William Joseph Ladipo Wright when he attained the age of 30 years, and married, and to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten by him.

(c) And on failure of issue on the death of the said William Joseph Ladipo Wright, in trust for the Settlor's other children who shall be living at the date of the death of the said William Joseph Ladipo Wright.

2. Emanuel Wright died.

3. William Joseph Ladipo Wright died at Abokuta, 1904, unmarried below the age of 30, and without any issue lawfully begotten by him.

4. The said Settlor Rufus A. Wright had other children lawfully begotten by him and living at the date of death of the said William Joseph Ladipo Wright, viz:—

(a) Charissa Layinka Agbebi (nee Wright,) born on the 15th of March, 1896, died on the 24th of April, 1924.

(b) Rufus Adekunle Wright, the Plaintiff, born on the 28th of August, 1900.

(c) Gladys Ayodele Wright, born on the 11th of April, 1902.

5. S. A. Leigh-Sodippe died 1906.
6. The Defendant, Kituyi Ajasa, as sole surviving trustee of Deed of Settlement has committed the following breaches of trust:—

(i) Permitting one Felicia Ayodele Wright to dispose of several of the trust properties referred to in Para. 1, for her sole use and benefit.

(ii) Selling several portions of the trust properties for the benefit of the creditors of the said Felicia Ayodele Wright.

(iii) Disposing of the sum of £1,000 received by him for the portion of the trust properties expropriated by the Government for the benefit of persons other than those entitled without investing same.

(iv) Converting to his own use and for the use of the creditors of the said Felicia Ayodele Wright, the rents and profits received in respect of Agege farm-lands commonly called Isheri lands.

7. Felicia Ayodele Wright died on the 17th of January, 1920, leaving by her Last Will and testament appointed the Defendants her Executors and Trustees.

8. The said Will was exhibited for Probate which was granted by this Honble Court on the 18th day of February, 1920, to above named Defendants.

9. The proceeds of the Sales made by Felicia Ayodele Wright (deceased) had never been invested in accordance with the provisions of the said trust Deed by the Defendant, Kituyi Ajasa.

10. The said Felicia Ayodele Wright disposed of several portions of the said trust properties with the knowledge and consent of the Defendant, Kituyi Ajasa, and converted the money to her own use with his (the Defendant, Kituyi Ajasa's) knowledge and consent.

The Plaintiff therefore claims:—

(a) As against both Defendants as Executors of the Estate of the said Felicia Ayodele Wright on account of all the lands sold and covered by the said Deed of Settlement by the late Felicia Ayodele Wright and for payment of one-third of the amount found due to the Plaintiff together with interest at the rate of 5 per cent per annum.

(b) As against the Defendant, Kituyi Ajasa, as the sole surviving trustee on account of all the unauthorized sales of lands by the said Felicia Ayodele Wright and all sales by him, as such sole surviving trustee.

(c) Replacement by the Executors of the Estate of the said Felicia Ayodele

Wright of all monies which may be found due against her Estate in respect of the unauthorized sales of the said lands and for payment over to the Plaintiff of $\frac{1}{4}$ share of the total amount found due on the taking of the said account with interest at the rate of five per cent per annum.

(d) Replacement by the Defendant, Kitoyi Ajasa, of all proceeds of sale of the said trust properties sold by Felicia Ayodele Wright or any other person in that behalf as from the 31st day of January, 1895, and proceeds of Sale made by him for the benefit of the creditors of the said Felicia Ayodele Wright, and for payment of $\frac{1}{4}$ of the amount found due with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent per annum to the Plaintiff.

(e) Partition of the remaining lands unsold situate at Ebute Metta, known as Wright's Town, as between the three children referred to in Para. 4, living at the date of the death of William Joseph Ladipo Wright.

(f) Partition of Agege Farm-lands described in the Deed of Settlement as Isheri Farm-lands as between the three children referred to in Para. 4, living at the date of the death of William Joseph Ladipo Wright.

(g) An account of the Rents received by the Defendant, Kitoyi Ajasa, as trustee of the Deed of Settlement in respect of Isheri Lands, commonly known as Agege Farm-lands.
