**FROM DENIGA'S "NOTES ON LAGOS STREETS."**

Historical Notes of the Principal Streets in towns through which His Royal Highness accompanied by His Excellency the Governor, will drive on Tuesday the 14th instant at 10 a.m.

**MARINA (GHINGHEII).**

This is named thus, owing to its being the chief place in which all refuse and dirt is generally deposited in the early days of Lagos.

**TINUBU SQUARE.**

This important Square, on which stands the Court House, is named after a lady by the name of Efunroye Tinubu an Eba, that may be said to have been the head cra of Lagos in years gone by; she came over from Abeokuta to this country through Badagry and carried on a most flourishing trade in Tobacco, etc. and was possessed of many slaves. She owned the present site of the Lagos Police Force, which it is said, she gave to the late Captain J. P. L. Davies in satisfaction of a debt. She left Lagos for Abeokuta on Tuesday 15th April, 1856, never to return.

**BROAD STREET.**

This is a principal thoroughfare. It extends from the Rio Course the Fields, to Parade Square, Old Olowo, being a distance of about 1 1/2 miles or 7722 feet or 1730 links.

**VICTORIA ROAD.**

This is named after Queen Victoria, popularly known as Victoria the Good on account of her peaceful reign; she was born in 1819. Ascended the throne 1837; joined the great majority January 21, 1901.

**BALOGUN STREET OR SQUARE.**

This spot is named after a man Ajeloya by name whose official title is the Ekegbo of Lagos; he began to flourish during King Ajas's time and took a very active part in all the wars of that time.

AKIRIMANU.

Wales, H. R. H. the Prince of Edward Albert  
Christian George Andrew Patrick David, born  
June 23, 1891 received naval training at Osborne and  
Dartmouth, succeeded to a winning pair in the Dartmouth  
Regatta, 1910. Invented a wireless set at Christchurch,  
1910. Middlebury, in Honduras, whence returned to sail.  
The Prince has, throughout his whole period of his train-  
ing, been an expert in boat work, and has struck a all  
forms about boats, flags and bows, as when we sail a five  
knigh, 1876, June 1911. Sailed some months in 1915,  
accompanying himself with France and the Langlois, in 17,  
Received the Legion of Honour from the President of July,  
1914, and the Cross of St. George, October 1915. Proposed  
Honorary on eve of taking a tour in Germany, March, 1915.  
Went through an extraordinary course at Magdalen College,  
Oxford. Performances first made study by laying foundation  
stone of St. Aspeton's Church, Kensington, in June, 1914.  
Went to the front in Nov., 1914, attached to Sir J. French's  
Staff, served with zeal and ardour, and was the bearer of  
historic dispatch from Sir J. French respecting the fall of  
Neuve Chapelle. Celebrated quickly the 21st birth day,  
June, 1915. As Officer of the Annonciade was given this  
by the King of Italy in July, 1915. In 1918 in March,  
1916, an appointment as Staff-Captain on the Staff of the  
General Office, command the 12th Mediterranean Experi-  
mentary Force. Became a Knight in May. Appointed in  
July, 1917; has been set to a visit to the Cheshire Regi-  
ment, Approved Grand Master of the Order of St. Michael  
and George. Visited Italian front during Austria's attack in  
November, 1917. Took his seat in the House of Lords  
Feb. 10, 1918. Appointed G.C.B. and, list of the Queen's  
Corps in United Kingdom. Appointed Knight in Feb. 1918.  
Received with honours in London in some, May, 1918. Re-  
ceive the Guards on their entry into London for review by

the King, March, 1919. Appointed Colonel-in-Chief of the  
12th Lancers and Royal Scots Fusiliers, April, 1919. Be-  
came Freeman of the City of London in May, and High  
Sheriff of Plymouth in June. Started for a visit to Canada  
and U.S.A., August, 1919, and was universal popularity  
in late several excellent speeches, and underwent many hon-  
ours. Had a separate home at St. James's Palace. Became  
on March 16, 1923, a long tour to Australia, returning in  
October, after crossing 45,000 miles and doing special  
service. Received a great welcome in London. Visited  
Glasgow in March, 1921. Appointed for Boy Scouts' Fund,  
and a large amount was received. Carried out with great  
success a long list of public engagements in 1921, 1922,  
1923, 1924, 1925, 1926, 1927, 1928, 1929, 1930, 1931,  
W. Lomas was only on his tour in India, Japan, and returned  
to England, June 23, 1922. Created a Knight of the Third  
class his birthday in 1927. Had a six days year of public  
service in 1931. Visited his Canadian ranch in September,  
1929. In February, 1924, opened new science buildings at Mill  
Hill School, and performed many other public duties.  
Wembley Exhibition bore much to his enthusiastic support.

**H. R. H. PRINCE OF WALES' SPEECH**  
AT  
THE ANNUAL CIVIL SERVICE DINNER IN LONDON.

"First-class stands are all the fashion just now. But when I look down the order of going in—I mean the toast list—(laughter) and see the great bassoon who are to follow and I find it is not for me to try to emulate either Hobbs or Wallace. (Laughter.) Though I feel to-night that the widest is an easy one, I shall not trouble you for many years.

"There are two things I must say after the extremely kind way in which you have received this toast. The first is to tell you how glad I am to meet here to-night such a large and representative gathering of Civil servants, and to have this chance of establishing the same personal association with you as with the other three Services. (Cheers.) I am delighted, too, to see representatives of the great Dominions with us. Their presence here makes this an assembly not only of the State workers of Great Britain, but of the whole of the Empire. (Hear, hear.) The task of preparing the toast of H.M. Civil Service has fallen, very appropriately, to the Prime Minister. I do not envy him his task, because it would be very difficult, if not impossible, to express in words the extent of the debt which this country owes to succeeding generations of Civil servant who, as Government follow-up Government, have never failed to serve him with unquestioned loyalty and efficiency. (Cheers.) It is not for me to enlarge on this subject to-night. I could not, however, sit down without paying my tribute to a Service which, with all my fellow-countrymen, I recognise as good in every sense of the word. (Cheers.)

"The other thing I want to say concerns the sport of the service and your schemes for organizing it on a solid basis. I am going to risk what I should call a very silly old proverb joke—so old that I cannot remember it; (laughter)—it was only told me to-day. It is that the Civil servants are like the fountain in Trafalgar Square—(laughter)—because they play from 10 till 4." (Laughter.)

It is just as absurd as the old saying, "all work and no play," etc., is true. I certainly think Civil servants should play—not necessarily from 10 to 4. (laughter.) Perhaps I can in a way put myself in your position, because we do not always feel in the best of tempers and up to all our work. If we get a chance of a game or of getting out, it does us better than anything else. (Hear, hear.) Those who work at mental occupations for their livelihood do their work all the better if they can keep themselves physically fit, and if any of you, any days of the year, can play from 10 to 4 (laughter), all the better.

Your Royal Highness,

Words fail me to express very adequately how jubilant we the loyal and dutiful subjects of His Majesty the King in our Dependency are, in welcoming Your Royal Highness to our shores: it is an open secret to say that since the last occasion of this country on August 6 1861, during the reign of King Dosumu, we have never been privileged so far as I know to our lot to record the visit of any member of the Royalty, beyond the seas, let alone that of an Heir-Apparent to the British Throne such as Your Royal Highness are, to this part of His Majesty's Dominions.

While from memory I believe that of all the colonies in West Africa—and in this I am open to correction,—no other colony of Sierra Leone alone was the first to enjoy the Royal visit in the year 1860 of His Royal Highness Prince Alfred, an occasion which was very significant in the annals of that ancient, loyal and progressive peninsula; and that that one of our own flesh and blood in the person of G. W. Johnson, popularly known in after years as the Reverend Johnson, Father of the E. G. U. United G. W. U. movement, came under the notice of the Royal Visitor with the privilege that the young African became as it were, the heir of His Royal Highness who eventually sent him to Europe for more training during those halcyon days.

To my Sir, that it has given us unqualified pleasure may I venture opportunity to see Your Royal Highness face to face, in a man likeeth to his friend—to borrow a theological terminology, is to give expression to poverty of language and we have that confident assurance, having regard to Your Royal Highness's social disposition and sportsmanship that in Your Royal Highness is found that magnanimous spirit as depicted by Cowper:—

"Floury locks and black complexion

Canst Ezzel Nature's claim;

Skins may differ, but aspirations and affections

Dwell in Black and White the same, (Italics, mine)

The only remarkable episode in the rift in the political life of this country occasioned by the ill-favour into which the accredited HEAD of our African community has fallen in the hands of "the powers that be" during the last five years, and would to GOD, Your Royal Highness sympathetic to our people in this their present predicament.

During Your Royal Highness's stay in our midst and throughout Your Royal Highness's 20,000 mile tour, may success in its thousand fold attend and crown Your Royal Highness's progress and egress.
