Once they attached themselves to it, nothing could drive them sway still they shall have killed the cocca tree by socking up its life blood—the juice entirely, leaving the withered stems and trunk at the mercy of the fre-wood collector.

It is true, the Agricultural Department had recommended pruning, thisning chemical washing ac. as preventives against the ravages of Black Pod pests, but the fact remains that whilst the Department had been able to democstrate these processes in the several farms with success, only very few farmers have ever tried out these experiments on their own cocoa farms in real carnestness. The result is that the Black Pod disease has been destroying tens of thousands of cocos trees every year and which are seldom replaced except by the creating of new year, only to be destroyed by the pests in the same way after a few years' time.

The worst and the most serious part of the present situation is the unpleasant fact that the aphies cauting this Black Pod disease has now extended its operation to the Kola Tree, our ancient economic plant.

It should not surprise farmers in Olonut, Epitesi, Agray Districts and Olevature to see their volumble Kola Teres withering and dying of by the thousands within the next of years as a result of the ravages of this peet which has already infected Kola trees from the decaying trunks of accost trees.

We understand the safest method in treating the post is by verying the sflaced trees with detentionals as well as thisming them with a view to belter vrabilisions on the plotation. The digging of trenches for burying hereits of the state of denying layers are also recommended by the Agricultural Department.
