FACTS AND FIGURES.

MARCUS GARVEY'S SCHEME NOT A JOKE!

BEGINNINGS OF AN ALL-BLACK DEMOCRACY.

Slowly but steadily the foundation of an All-Black Democracy is being laid by a coal-black, kinky-haired, West Indian Negro (in New York City) known the world over as Marcus Garvey.

To him who studies things only on the surface, Marcus Garvey's Programme of an All-Black Republic in Africa is a wild cat scheme, a pipe dream, a fantastic, abortive and grossly fanatical enterprise which deserves to be laughed away as many times as one hears of it.

But to the observer who could see far beyond his nose and study deep below the surface, the keen observer, the student of political science and psychology, the programme drawn by Marcus Garvey is one that should arrest the serious attention and thought of both white and black people alike.

Perhaps Negroes—stay-at-home Negroes—this side of the world would not admit that the United States of America is, to-day, the centre of Negro thought the world over—but we trow not. We are apt to lull ourselves to sleep more often than not, over the pet idea that our wants and aspirations are not identical with those of the Afro-Americans or the West Indians. This may be so to some extent; but inasmuch as we are bound to face the fact that the fundamental aims at the back of the Black Man's Mind are the same everywhere, it is but wise that we recognise that inseparable link which binds one Negro and the other no matter in what empire, kingdom or republic—country or clime—each is destined to live.

Indeed Marcus Garvey might have made some mistakes as regards the details of his programme—he being a human being—but even this is a matter of opinion. What really is of primary importance is the principle underwriting such scheme—a principle which, granted for the moment that Marcus Garvey fails, will yet come up again some day.

It should not be distorted into a theory that Marcus Garvey wants the whole continent of Africa—including independent Egypt, South Africa, etc.—for his Republic Scheme. No. But, at any rate, the idea of a portion in the vast African continent, entirely independent of any foreign domination, governed on modern lines for and by the Negro people is in no way offensive.

The way of men, such as Marcus Garvey is no bed of roses. Troubles have been raked against him over and over again. Liberia which in 1920 agreed and made a Treaty to the effect that Marcus Garvey's men are welcome in Liberia has now turned round to act counter to such Treaty.

And Liberia of all nations?—Well might Garvey exclaim in the language of Shakespear: *Eta Brute!*

Evidently foreign justice is at work to prevent the practicability of Garvey's object—an object which people here, in their ignorance, are prepared to laugh away as a big joke.

Says *The Daily Telegraph* :—

"...Despite all that is said against him (Garvey) the ovation he received to-day when the Convention resumed shows that he still retains the affection and even the confidence of his coloured friends.

"Garvey declares that there is some mistake about Liberia which will be corrected later, and in the mean time he urges that there are other places in Africa where coloured folks are welcome "and where a chance exists to establish a great base of Negro Civilization." He is now in touch with Empress Zauditu of Abyssinia."

Such is the position of Marcus Garvey and there is no level-headed Negro who in his heart of hearts does not agree with the principle advocated by him notwithstanding difference in details.

The Nigerian National Democratic Party in General Meeting assembled this 18th day of October 1924 have unanimously passed the following important Resolution. 2,468 members present at the Gloyer Memorial Hall.—

RESOLVED:—That in view of urgent necessity for a continuity of policy at this stage in the administrative history of Nigeria when this important Dependency is enjoying internal peace and is about to enter upon a period of progressive development and commercial prosperity, this community views with alarm and regret the present decision of the Secretary of State to transfer almost simultaneously on promotion to other Colonies, His Excellency Sir Hugh Clifford and Sir Donald Cameron, the two highest Executive officers who are thoroughly conversant with Nigerian Affairs, and this community in the circumstances expresses the anxious hope that His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for the Colonies may be graciously pleased to consider the advisability of retaining the valuable services of Sir Donald Cameron in succession to Sir Hugh Clifford as Governor of Nigeria.
