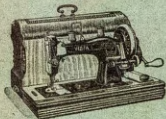

Report of the First Parochial Anniversary

of

St. Paul's Church, Breadfruit.

To the Editor

— Eko Akete —

Sir,

Above is the title of a new publication recently issued under the auspices of St. Paul's Church's Authorities. It is the first of its kind in the history of the Church and reflects much credit on the organising ability of the Pastor of the Church, the Venerable Archbishop, Theo. A. J. Oganbisi whose creative genius, magnetic influence and force and indomitable energy have become proverbial in the Christian world of Nigeria.

To aver that the able person is highly esteemed by his Parishioners is to reiterate a well known fact but the meaning of the word "Heast of Burden" which he employs in referring to himself in a letter dated 21st March, 1922 to his congregation published in a page opposite his own photograph in the Reports really passesh our understanding. We do not think it is a distinction to be a "Heast of Burden" and it would appear to be the fate of those Parishioners whose Pastors are a source of burden to them. But perhaps the reverend gentleman will illustrate his meaning and thus dispel a thick cloud of gross misunderstanding. We know the Archbishop, very well and are well aware of his kind and sympathetic disposition towards all and sundry.

The English Edition of the Report under review was ably compiled by Mr. A. E. Norman Williams who acquitted himself of the task in a manner quite complementary to his ripe intelligence. It is not a voluminous document and though concise, the brevity is not maintained at the expense of non reporting any event that really matters. Practically the whole ground is covered and we admire Mr. Williams' dexterity and diplomatic aliation to Rev. C. E. Doherty, B. A.

The People's Warden, Mr. E. W. George who was responsible for the translation of the work into Yoruba language has contributed his own quota towards the success of the undertaking and the popularity that awaits the Brochure. And although Mr. George's work in this respect is devoid of originality the thanks and encomiums of the Church are no less due to him. Translation, after all, is not such an easy task as many an inexperienced is apt to think and to be able

to sufficiently realize the difficulty which it involves, one only has to remember the several-brother-getten incident of an old celebrated African Catechist who, whilst interpreting in English sermon to one of the Anglican Church's Congregation here some years ago, rendered the meaning of "Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me," as "Iyo, Iyo, billose ti enyin ko dan abo" (I swear of laughter).

On Page 6 of the Report is published a Programme of the first Parochial Anniversary Meeting, held on May 2nd, 1922, in the School Room, at 7 p.m. under the Presidency of J. T. N. Cole Esq. B.L., with a Resolution to continue or celebrate future Anniversaries of the Meeting. If this Parochial Anniversary Meeting was a fully representative one as it ought to be, then the Resolution of the Parish Girls' Own Public Meeting held on May 5th, 1922, on the same subject is as useless as the fulfilment of a Coach unless the promoters of the latter meeting are a separate body who do not form part and parcel of the whole Parishioners which the former meeting represented and consequently the decision of the one is not valid without the express sanction and ratification of the other.

In Page 19, the compiler Mr. A. E. Norman Williams tells us that "This Report will be based upon the work done from the 1st day of April 1921, to the 31st day of March, 1922, and in Page 12 of the Report we find a list of appointments made during the period. But on comparison, the list is not in conformity with the supposed photographs of the officers appointed during this period." Fancy, in Page 20 we find Mr. Wey surging the right of Mr. A. E. Norman Williams as Parochial Secretary and the latter occupying Mr. O. H. Williams, the Pastor's Warden's room.

The same remarks apply to other exhibits in the Pamphlet and this irregularity accounts for non appearance of men like Messrs. J. F. Coler, James Hooley and G. O. Awesohi in the group photograph of the Parochial Committee Members. The Compiler owes each of these men an unequalled apology, and, to some extent, we think the non inclusion of the omitted serious omission, unless the Auditors Messrs C. A. J. Williams and E. A. O. Igbaji had not properly discharged their duties and any delinquency on their part does not appear to have been the case.

On the whole the Report is satisfactory, and we congratulate all concerned.

SORINOLU'S GRAMMAR SCHOOL.

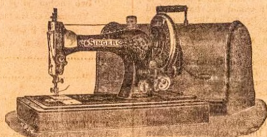
The first ever Established in Abeokuta and Ibe-Ode.

Dear Sir,—My attention has been called to a portion of a "Letter from Abeokuta" of the 1st instant, published by your contemporary, the *African Messenger*, detailing the "circumstances" causing the tragical death of my Grammar School, Iporo-Ake, Abeokuta, established January 22, 1906 on July 1908.

than an alleged opinion of mine on marriage which is more of a social than an ecclesiastical concern. I am simply amused to read the story; and I would not have replied had he not concluded by saying the Anglicans had re-established at Igbain where their Grammar School once stood in 1867.

Now, Sir, there was no Grammar School at Igbain then but a Divinity school to train up pastors, evangelists, and teachers for evangelizing the Egbas and the surroundings. It would be absurd to start up a Grammar School in a yet unevangelised land as Abeokuta was in 1867. With difficulty, much coaxing and bribing the Day and Infant scholars were then found. The Institute suffered in the outbreak of 1867, subsequently removed to Lagos, and thence to Qyo in the 80's where it still stands a Divinity school or college to this very day. Therefore it is a veritable fact that my humble effort of January 22, 1906, so sorely persecuted by the mighty ones for no just cause, has been the first ever established Grammar School in Abeokuta. A branch of this also was the first ever planted at Jel'u Ode.
