Gallant Captain,

It is stated on good authority that an Application for a Pass lately submitted to your force by some person or persons in Iwo for drumming around the funeral obsequies of a man by the name of Longe, a noted Native Doctor of his Guild, who died not long ago at his residence, Ladoke, Lagos, was refused by the Police on the ground that drumming is prohibited in certain parts or parts of that vicinity.

So far as I know, this neighbourhood has not been declared a liability area by the "powers that be," where no noise is generally always unwholesome, especially during the adulation of cases, and perhaps the only reason which can be asserted, to my knowledge, is that the application was refused principally because the residence of a highly-placed Police Officer is situated therabouts. If this is so, then there is my opinion, a refusal such as this certainly looks that Stratocracy which once existed to see displayed by an average Peace Officer towards those under the Protection of His Majesty the King. Others sharing of this incident and the circumstances surrounding it, may not unusually characterize the whole, as show as Abuse of Official Power, and so it accrues.

The public, sir, will hear of this happening with much regret, particularly, when it is known that "A little Sympathy goes a long way in this world." Would you mind doing your best to guide against the execution of the act in future? I trust your good sense.


