Gallant Captain,

It is stated on good authority that an Application for a Pass lately submitted to your Force by some persons or persons in Town, for drumming about the funeral obsequies of a man by the name of Louge, a noted Native Doctor of his Guild, who died not long ago at his residence, Tafaji, Lagos, was refused by the Police on the ground that drumming is prohibited in certain part or parts of that vicinity.

So far as I know, this neighbourhood has not been declared a judicial area by the " Powers that be " where no noise is generally always unwelcome, especially during the adjudication of cases, and perhaps the only reason which can be asserted, in my knowledge, is that the application was refused principally because the residence of a high-placed Police Officer is situated thereabouts.

If this is so, then in my opinion, a refusal such as this certainly does not STRIKE which one expects to be employed by an over-zealous " Officer " towards those under the protection of His Majesty the King. Others hearing of this incident and the circumstances surrounding it, may not uncharitably characterize the whole as an Abuse or OFFICIAL POWER, and so it seems.

The public, or, will hear of this happening with much sympathy, particularly, when it is known that " A little Sympathy goes a long way in this world ".

Would you mind doing your best to guide against the recurrence of the act in future ? I trust your good sense.
