SIR, RALPH COMBE KNT.

Chief Justice,

Lagos, Nigeria.

Your Honour,

Knowing as I do your large heart and broad sympathies not less than your strict sense of duty, it will I take it grieve you to learn that under present arrangements, by which litigants living in certain parts not remote from the Law Courts in town are made to attend to their law-suits in The District Court of Ebute-Meta much inconvenience is caused in this community.

Under this Order, I am told that the jurisdiction of the latter Court extends from Ebute-Ero to the very heart of Tinubu Square, and goes on to Broad Street with a terminus at Oke Olowogbosi!!!, also that European Firms doing business in the Block are exempt from its operations.

Very recently, the case of a gentleman whose residence is in juxtaposition with the Law Courts at Tinubu and whose application for a civil summons against another party who also lives within a stone's throw of the Judiciary was reported to me; the applicant being directed to Ebute Meta before his wants could be met, in spite of the fact that Tinubu Court-house is AT HIS VERY DOOR!!!, that he was allowed to "strive in the midst of plenty".

I cannot conscientiously congratulate the Government on the bungling business, which to my mind shows neither foresight nor system and the sooner the Order is rescinded the better will it be for all concerned.

This anomaly need only be brought to your notice, and I am sure it is a foregone conclusion, that necessary RELIEF will follow.

## MUSICAL EVENING

U.N.A. CHURCH.

On Friday June 22, 1923, I attended a Service of Songs for Harvest-time, held by Jehovah Shalom Church Choir. The service began at about 7 45 p.m. instead of 7 30 p.m. as announced in the Notice. There was a fairly good number of choristers on the choir stall. After the opening hymn and prayer, Mr. C. B. Williams sang a solo; he in his usual melodious voice commanded my attention and left no room for want. Mr. C. B. Williams appeared in an Evening Dress, as one of the partakers on the occasion he was expected to appear in choir robes amongst the choristers, but this was not so, I understand for certain reason. Mrs. Antus Williams took part at the service and was found in the cory of choristers. The part allotted to her was quite appropriate "All is Beautiful," it was beautifully rendered. Amongst the items of programme, there was only one duet and was rendered by a soprano and a contralto; it seemed to be the best of all other items and was very well rendered. The boy that sang the soprano part deserves merit, it he is given a fair training, he may likely become one of the best sopranos in the African Communion. Judging the average ability of the choir, the performance of the evening was successful, although from musical standpoint, some of the songs were not very interesting. The frequent Bible reading suffered the service to become lukewarm, despite a few well-known hymns that were included which the congregation heartily joined occasionally.

The Organist should be congratulated upon his efforts which contributed to the success of the evening as the result of his patient labour. I think a word of advice may do him some good. I advise he should learn the use of harmonium stops and should not in future content himself with a set of stops from start to finish. He should note carefully and act on the directions of musical degree. He should keep as far as possible the same time with the choir, and listly should not the accompanying part to cover the choir when singing or whenever a solo is being rendered.

The Service was brought to close at 6 p.m. with benediction.
