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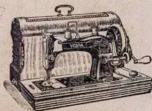

THE FOREMOST MAN.

M. Pöschner is the foremost man in European politics of to-day. From the President of the League of Nations during the world-war, to the Emperor's ambassador, to the world-wide, for 478, Laweyer and was one as in a liability; he looks upon his European affairs, the former President of the League and other parts of the League of Nations, in the Rhine and other parts of Germany occupied by the French. (When I say that my work was at the beginning, I do not mean that the French President may initiate another war but simply that he has the European situation in his hand by his machinery and material policy.) He is rightly or wrongly called "the foremost man" in the world. He is of such stature that he would make no show of form in the allied demands from Germany by paying to her almost exactly the millions measured by the price of the war (1914-18) but she had indicated and that she must

not be allowed the remote chance of getting on her feet as a world power for the second time before paying her liabilities.

Private politics between nations, and an *anti-fascist* from our chief defects in Nigeria, especially in Lagos, by the power of history rhetoric, story, parables, character sketches, etc. The liberal soul shall be made "liberal" by Holy writ, and a liberal soul must be a *non-fascist* man to responsible quarters. Liberty of sentiment must be an obvious necessity. Obscurive conservatism and loyalty to great Britain, while finally to Nigeria remains an undesirable object to a large portion of the so-called advanced and more enlightened class among us. Liberal opinion is essential to our existence as a race, and a free hospital outlook on things will bring us nearer and nearer to our desired haven. *Loyalty* to Nigeria, as not less a portion of the British Commonwealth than Great Britain as a European power, not something ago in one of our social papers. The electric franchise is quite contradictory to the *Saxon Hegemony* whereby, as advocated by some. Political parties have already been formed in the country. Are these parties called into existence as permanent institutions or do they exist for the time being as long as the current of events of late had or are these parties concurrent with these events, only? That is the anxious question of the moment. It is well-known, indeed, that these political parties to wit Democratic Party, People's Union, Young Nigerians, and Reform Club, are of diversified opinions concerning political matters, that we sincerely hope that they will not differ as to the things that really matter. The total combination of color preferences in the fight our hero of the hour is pulling on now to renounce France and may the efforts of M. Pöschner and his noble sentiment rascals among his British allies so that the British dominions may once more know an unshackled exercise of their liberties and privileges and that the magnanimity of the President may triumph over all adverse forces, so that all animosities may be swallowed up in a joy of unshackled humanity to glory and peace of God.
