TELEGRAM

SECRETARY OF STATE, LONDON, TO GOVERNOR, LAGOS,
DATED 20TH OCTOBER, 1921.

20th October. His Majesty has approved following arrangements for observance in this country Armistice Day November 11th. (1) Short Service will be held at Cenotaph on the lines adopted in the previous years including Hymn "O God our help in ages past." His Majesty the King will be present and will lay a wreath (2) 30 minutes' silence will be observed at 11 a.m. (3) The authorities in this country will be asked to arrange the suspension of all vehicular traffic for two minutes from 11 a.m., but rail and water transport will not be suspended.

I propose to lay wreath on behalf of the Colonies and Protectorates.

Since the preliminary arrangement for this daily newspaper with its special cable service, have been made, it has recently been announced that another daily newspaper will appear, and intending subscribers and advertisers are cautioned against confusing this with the "Nigeria Daily Times."

MAXIMS—AND COUNTER-MAXIMS.

A saw cuts in one direction. So does the maxim. The aim, or adage, or proverb is a half-truth which, to quote truly pragmatic needs to be added to its complementary attachment, and, like a happy married pair, each so wise, so true, so beautiful, that we can scarcely tell who has the better half. Maxims are like lawyers who need cases on both sides of a case. They disregard half-evidence, and formulate their proposition or defence in single crisp sentences. "He who hesitates is lost," says the "Lark" before you kill," says the other.

We need but produce a short list of contradictory saws in order to prove our point. Examine them, we see how incorrect it is to derive wisdom from knowledge.

A man is known by the company he keeps. Apparentees are deceitful. Honesty is the best policy.

The truth is not to be spoken at all times.

Too many cooks spoil the broth.

In a multitude of counsellers there is wisdom.

Out of sight, out of mind.

A rolling stone gathers no moss.

A sitting hen never grows fat.

Strike while the iron is hot.

A patient bird catches the worm.

There are as good fish in the sea as ever were caught.

It never rains but it pours.

History should have a silver lining.

One swallow does not make a summer.

Straw shows which way the wind blows.

This is a long time that has no turning.

It is never too late to mend.

Poverty makes strange bedfellows.

Births of a nation flock together.

The gods give nuts to those that have no teeth.

God tempers the wind to the shorn lamb.

That it is seen that truth is too ethereal, too elastic, to be compressed into a single sentence. To sail directly to our destination we must beat back and forth from one application to another. The conception of truth as definite and therefore definable is misleading. Truth is an abstraction, hypothesis, and as impossible to conceive as in the mathematical hypothesis of infinity. The nearest approach we can make to infinity is by means of series, increasing rather. Yet finally according to geometry is itself infinite. Yet finally according to geometry is itself finite. Inside the parabola is less than the infinite area outside the same curve. Nevertheless, the formula of the parabola is a means of describing its shape, though its direct meaning is false.

All maxims, adages, proverbs have their place: for they include axioms. They have stood the test of time and are applicable as fitting vehicles whereby to convey amusement, instruction, and content in certain environments to past, present, and future generations. For—

And what are proverbs but the people's voice?

Of good food, and current made by common choice.

Then sure they must have weight and truth withal:—

Moreover, as we must have our shocks from which to bind our little houses, so we must have our precepts from which to build houses. Some of the rough proverbs of life must be compressed into maxims and proverbs in order to conserve for youth the experience of mankind. Children need to have empirical rules, but they must learn to transcend themselves, and if it not null they have done so, then they find the utility of attempting to formulate life

and conduct into any definite code. We teach them the primary colours; but they must find their own purple to the landscape, and think of it, too, as purple, rather than as a combination of blue and red.

Another application of the adage is the essay; and even this can scarcely do more than suggest. When the essay attempts to assert, the opposite statement springs up, and challenges our attention, as red, too long stated, induces a sensation of green. The function of the essay is whether to suggest, to induce a new point of view, or whether to convert its proposer to this fresh way of looking at things, or convince him in the old opinion, matters little if so be it has made him think. The essay should be conservative rather than the destructive: its function being to inspire our imaginations.

Maxims pave the way for thought; and on them we go faster and faster, though we go only on the beaten track. Like bolts, they present only a level of a truth. Yet, with the old bolts, fastenings, eccentricities, cracks, and heretics, the world would not progress at all; for these, possessed of but one side of a truth, hearish their saws and precepts as weapons and hew a way for us. Through abstraction and denial we make a zigzag towards reform.

Push on one pedal of your bicycle, and the other comes up to your foot ready for its impulse. So, alternating, we go forward with never a stroke clearly driven in the true direction, we wait to take. Maxim and counter-maxim, theory and converse, proposition and contrary, rule and exception, orthodoxy and heterodoxy, appeal in law, and each couple, opposite paired, does not make zero, like positive and negative terms, but a mechanical couple ensuring reaction. Both are true; both are false.

Still, we go progress. We are like points on the rim of a wheel, thinking that, while we are rising and falling to a maximum and contrabictory adage, we are merely revolving in futile rotation. Instead, we are all carried forward in a secret curve of beauty, the beautiful arch of the cypher.
