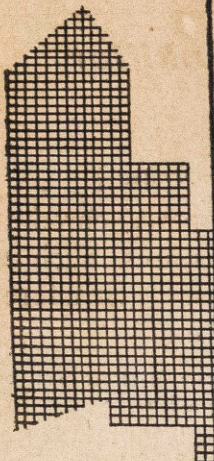

Awa ko fi igba kan ni igbago wipe Makoli ko awon ara ilu yi jo si ikoko tabi ni ibaba kan wipe ti ofin ate ilu lorun kan ba fe wo ilu ki nwon gbe ogun tabi itakanrangban si i—şugbon ede irira ni awon enia buburu ma nso si Makoli lara, nwon a si fe lati ma fihan wipe o nda ilu ru tabi o ngbote si alafia ilu, be bi o ti wa ki o pe to, oloto ko ni ku si ipo ika, emi pelu alafia ni ki a ma toro ki a maşe ri dasi kan—Amiu.

A ha le şiro ise ribiribi ti Makoli se si oran ile— Dosunmu tan, lori eyiti a nwi gan ninu wosika yi; a ri ka ninu iwe pataki kan ti o se nipa ile Qba Dosunmu ni iwon odun melo şehin bayi pe :—

This Treaty provides, *on the one hand*, for the cession of the port and Island of Lagos to the Queen of Great Britain, *her heirs and successors for ever*; but the same Treaty also provides, *on the other hand*, for King Dosunmu, the negro sovereign, an annual pension equal to the net revenue annually received by him before the cession *only for his lifetime* and not to be paid to his heirs and successors or descendants, and without reference to future developments of the country, where to-day the annual revenue to the British Government is four million sterling, and the total value of raw material and produce exported in one year amounted to £8,482,000, a figure which by no means represents the entire productive capacity of the British Colony and protectorate, the richest and desert districts of which have not even yet been developed or even tapped.

Upon the death of King Dosunmu the negro King, his son Oyekan was installed paramount chief of Lagos and head of the house of Dosunmu, in which position he was recognised by the British Government, but not until after repeated representations were made to the Government was he allowed to draw what was officially styled "a compassionate allowance of £500 a year".

After the death of Prince Oyekan, his brother, Prince Eshugbayi Eleko, was appointed and installed head of the house of Dosunmu, with a dwindling "compassionate allowance" of only £300 a year, which was graciously vouchsafed to His Royal Highness by the British Government, and which has more than once been withheld by the Lieut.-Governor, who (in the absence of the Governor and Commander-in-Chief) once told the Prince to stand up and not sit down when speaking to him, the supreme representative in Nigeria of British Sovereignty.

To-day in Nigeria the salary of a Chief clerk on the native staff of the Civil Service is £300, and the salary of the lowest class of European civil servant (a foreman of works or a gardener) is £420, and the revenue is four million sterling.

The Island of Lagos, by virtue of its geographical position, is the keystone of an immense country abounding in unlimited resources as well as the source of in calculable advantages to British industry and commerce, the phenomenal expansion of its trade being far from reaching its climax at the present time, fraught as the whole country is with incalculable potential developments, countless mineral wealth, and an almost



indefinite supply of raw—Nigeria, with its population of seventeen million negroes, scattered over 335,700 square miles, about three three times the size of the United Kingdom, is the largest of the British West African possessions; and it is the cession of the Island of Lagos by Dosunmu, the negro king, which has made it possible for Great Britain to possess to-day the sovereignty over such a valuable colony and protectorate as a portion of the British Empire.

The once royal house of Dosunmu, which was royal enough to receive the British—commander in 1861, and to cede its sovereignty of the British Crown [has been left to fall to pieces, and only a pittance of £300 a year is paid to the living successor of the negro king who, by signing the Treaty of August 6, 1861, has handed to the British Government the Island of Lagos, yielding a revenue to-day of four million sterling yearly.

Will the British nation allow this injustice to continue to the house of Dosunmu, which for twenty-four years after the cession, but has been deprived of more than £24,000 for having charged the anomalous slave protectorate of Lagos, in the Bight of Benin, on the West Coast of Africa, into an avowed occupation by the British Government under a Treaty in which Dosunmu signed away his own sovereignty under reser.?

In a speech to the House of Lords in the year 1870 with reference to the "Benadetti Treaty" on the disclosures of negotiations between France and Russia respecting Belgium, Lord John Russell said—

Let me again remind your lordships of the obligations of the most sacred king into which we have entered to guarantee the independency and neutrality of Belgium. We are bound to defend Belgium. I am told that that may lead us into danger. I deny that any danger would exist if the country manfully declared her intention to stand by her treaties and not to shrink from the performance of all her engagements. When the choice is between honour and infamy, I cannot doubt that her Majesty's Government will pursue the course of honour, the only one worthy of the British people. The main thing is how we can best assure Belgium, assure Europe, assure the world that the great name which we have acquired by the constant observation of truth and justice will not be departed from, and that we shall be in the future what we have been past.

Now, with regard to the House of Dosunmu of Lagos, the British Government has never paid to the negro king "a pension equal to the net revenue received by him" before the cession, nor was king Dosunmu "permitted to use his

stamps" on any Crown Grant issued after the cession in terms of Article 3 of the Treaty; as the stamp of Dosunmu, which was to be proof that there were no native claims upon such lands as were being transferred, was never once affixed to single copy of the 3500 Crown Grants issued by the Government after the cession.

The island of Lagos was ceded to the Queen of Great Britain, her heirs and successors for ever, but Dosunmu, the negro king, was to have pension "only during his lifetime," and he had "to resign all claim upon all former farmers of the revenue".—Reproduced from *Justitia Fiat*, by Herbert Macaulay C.E., January 1921.

Lehin iku Oba Dosunmu, Oyekan omo re bo si ori oye si inu ile-Dosunmu, Ijoba Gesi si fawogba a gegebi Arole-ile Dosunmu, sugbon ki Ijoba to beresi sanwo (Remilekun ododon £500) edegbeta Ponun, ogoro iwe ni nwon fi se si Ijoba.

Lehin iku omoba Oyekan, omoba Esugbaya Eleko aburo re li a fi role Dosunmu eyiti awon din owo-ododon tire ku si odun Ponun (£300) owo eyiti o se wipe o ni iye igba ti Arole Gomina ma ndaduro nigbagbogbo nigbati Oloja Gomina papa ko ba si ni ile, Arole Gomina si so fun omoba Oba yi lekan ri pe ni iwon igba ti o nba fe soro ni iwaju on, o ni lati ma dide duro mitori on ni Asoju Oba King ilu oyinbo.

ni oḍoḍun ninu re, o di ibiti Ijoba ko bikita fun mo, ti nwon si nwan owo palanta oḍunrun Pḍunnu (£300) fun loḍoḍun.

Wayi o Ijoba ki san owo to fun idile Dosunnu, gegebi owo ti o uti inu ilu bo sinu apo Ijoba, beni a ko si gba Dosunnu laye ki o fi Aworan Oute (Stamp) arare te iwe gegebi adehun ti o mbe ninu Majemu ke.a.

Qba Dosunnu o fi Eko si abe abo Ijoba Igesi ati si abe aramodomo won titi gbere, ati pe, eniti o se iru eyi, a kan nfun ni owo-oḍoḍun fun *igbesi aye re nikan*, ati pe ko si ni ase kase kan lori awon ara ilu re bikosi eyiti Ijoba ba pa.

A fo oro Qlola John Russell eyiti o so ni Ile awon Ologboni (House of Lord) ni oḍun 1870, nigbati nwon nse ope-alaiye oro ilu Belgium, gegebi a ti fi pelu oro ti a nka fun nyin yi ni ede ti Igesi lohun.

Ninu iwe ti Makoli se ti a npe ni "Justitia Fiat" ti o se ni oḍun 1921 oḍun keje oḍun ni a ti yo oro wonyi.

Eniti o ba ka oro iwe na pelu lakayi yio ri dajudaju pe kosi oro ti o mu irifin dani bikoḣe oro ti o nja fun anfani ile Qba Dosunnu, ti o si le fun ilu yi ni irorun.
