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Meet The New President Of America: Lyndon B. Johnson

Lyndon B. Johnson, the new President of the United States, was his predecessor John F. Kennedy, has been a warm supporter of African independence and economic progress.

He was born on August 27 1908, gained B.Sc. degree in state Teachers' College and was a teacher for several years in public schools.

Vice President

Mr Johnson, Vice President under Mr. Kennedy, became the nation's 36th Chief of State on November 22 when President Kennedy was felled by an assassin's bullet in Dallas, Texas.

During the Kennedy Administration, Mr. Johnson had an opportunity to meet with a number of African leaders while they were in the United States. On some occasions, he acted as Mr. Kennedy's personal greeter in welcoming distinguished visitors to Washington. He attended most state luncheons and dinners for distinguished African leaders at the White House and met with many of them in his office.

Africa's Friend

We went to Africa in April of 1961 as President Kennedy's personal representative to Senegal's independence celebrations. The visit was recognized as a mark of the Kennedy Administration's keen interest in Africa.

Mr. Johnson's views on Africa can be summed up in a statement he made two years ago while greeting a visitor from Africa:

"It is not only to our interest but it is our desire that the young African nations have the economic health that will enable them to live not only in dignity but in proud independence . . ."

"We have spent so many decades in winning the wilderness and pushing back the physical frontier that we have not lost our sense of adventure — our pleasure over the launching of a new nation. In the last few years new nations after new nations have been launched in the Great Continental of Africa."

"The Sleeping child has risen from the slumber of centuries and is stepping bodily in the 20th century. Because we remember our birth pangs we are more than anxious and eager to extend the helping hand of cooperation."

"We in America welcome our new neighbors in Africa. We wish them well. We re-

joice when they flourish and share their happiness in a bright future."

Mr. Johnson was accorded a tremendous welcome in Senegal and he assured the people that the United States hopes for "very friendly and mutually beneficial relation" with all the African nations.

Independence, he stressed, "is not an end in itself but a means to prove the lot and enlarge the opportunities for all the people."

The United States, Mr. Johnson declared, felt a kinship for the African nations because "we walked this road of independence ourselves."

As he travelled about Senegal, Mr. Johnson said he saw in the "eyes of the people an expression of genuine friendship toward America and a desire to build up their country dignity, peace and justice for all."

Nigerian Prime Minister Balewa visited the United States in mid-1961 and Vice President Johnson represented President Kennedy at the airport arrival ceremony. He told the Prime Minister:

"You will find as you travel through this country a deep interest in the exciting developments which are taking place in Africa today with the formation of new, self-governing, independent states."

"This is one of the most significant events of modern times."

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International Court Decision On Cameroun's Complaint

LONDON—The International Court of Justice ruled on Monday, December 2, that the ending of the British Trusteeship over the Cameroons and the joining of the Northern Cameroons to Nigeria were not acts by Britain but the result of actions of the United Nations General Assembly.

The International Court ruled that it would not adjudicate on the Cameroun Republic's complaints about Britain's administration of the Cameroons Trust Territory and, in particular, about the conduct of the 1961 plebiscite there.

The plebiscite asked the people of the Northern and Southern Cameroons whether they wished to become independent by joining the former French Trust Territory of Cameroun or joining Nigeria. The people of the Northern Cameroons voted to join Nigeria and the people of the Southern Cameroons voted to join Cameroun (which, like Nigeria, had become independent in 1960).

The United Nations General Assembly later endorsed the decision.

sed the result of the plebiscite, considered that the people of the two parts of the territory had freely and secretly expressed their wishes, and decided that Trusteeship Agreement placing the Northern Cameroun under British administration should end on June 1, 1961.

The International Court ruled that the Cameroun Republic could no longer ask it to adjudicate on this question. The ending of the Trusteeship Agreement and the joining of the Northern Cameroons to Nigeria "were not the acts of United Kingdom but the results of actions of the United Nations General Assembly." It was the Assembly which had decided to end the Trusteeship Agreement.

Churchill Celebrates 89th Birthday



LONDON... Rt Hon. Winston Churchill, oldest statesman in England celebrated his 89th birthday on Saturday November 30 last week in his country home. Former Prime Minister Sir Winston, as Home Secretary introduced Prison Reforms to Great Britain in 1910. He recently resigned from active politics early this year.

LONDON—The Duke of Edinburgh will represent the Queen at tea independence celebrations in Zanzibar and Kenya next week. The following announcement was made by Buckingham Palace yesterday, Monday: "The Queen, at the request of the Prime Ministers of Zanzibar and of Kenya, has invited H.R.H. the Duke of Edinburgh to visit Zanzibar and Kenya as Her Majesty's Special Representative at the Zanzibar and Kenya's Independence Celebrations. His Royal Highness has accepted with much pleasure."
