WESTERN REGIONAL PRODUCTION DEVELOPMENT BOARD SCHOLARSHIPS



The Western Regional Production Development Board is prepared to award about 120 Scholarships in the following fields of learning during the current year:

PROFESSIONAL: Agriculture, Architecture, Chemistry, Economics, Engineering (Aeronautical, Agricultural, Metallurgical, Buildings, Civil, Marine, Mining, Mechanical, and Electrical), Telegraphy, Textile, Town Planning, Water, Estate Management, Farm Management, Forestry, Geology, Horticulture, Marine Navigation, Statistics, Veterinary Science, Building, Carpentry, Catering, Diesel Mechanics, Food Processing, Hotel & Salms, Masonry, Mechanics, Radiography, Saw Mill Technology, Soap Technology, Telecommunication, Textiles, Textile Design, Wireless.

TECHNICAL: Brickmaking, Pottery, and Ceramics, Shoemaking, Watch repairing.

TRADES: Accountancy, Banking, Business Administration, Business Management, Co-operation, Insurance, Secretarial, Stenography.

2. The minimum qualifications required from applicants for courses leading to professional qualifications is the Grade II Cambridge School Certificate with exemption from London Matriculation. Applicants with higher qualifications will have a greater chance of success. Lower qualifications may be considered for the technical and trade scholarships. Female candidates possessing Grade III School Certificate with credit in English will be considered for a course in Stenography. Applicants are advised to ensure that their academic qualifications are suitable for the courses proposed.

3. Candidates intending to proceed to the University College Ibadan must have passed the Entrance Examination to the College before they can be favourably considered. Successful candidates will be placed either in the University College, Ibadan, Nigerian College, or Arts, Science and Technology and Technical Institutes in Nigeria or other Countries of learning in the English-speaking world. Applications from students already in Universities may also be considered provided that financial difficulties can be proved and favourable reports on progress are available.

4. Application Forms can be obtained from the Secretary, Western Regional Production Development Board, Ibadan.

5. Application Forms must be returned to the Secretary to the Scholarship Board through the Head of Department, Principal of a College or Employer and should reach the Secretary to the Scholarship Board not later than 7th September, 1953.

6. Applicants who resort to canvassing with Executive, Board and Selection members will be disqualified.

ENDLESS PROMISE

Since the end of the war, there has been a general feeling that the Public Relations Dept. as we know it requires a complete and thorough overhauling if it is to serve much useful peace time purpose. With the phenomenal changes which have since then taken place in the constitutional set up in the country, that need has become still more urgent and imperative. Everybody in the civil service demands for the reorganization and sees the Government as being ill-advised.

But what has the Government done to show that it is taking steps to meet this urgent need. For the past 24 months the public has been fed an empty diet of promises without any visible sign of attempts to redeem those promises. Early in 1952, His Excellency the Governor in his speech from the Throne in the House of Representatives gave the assurance that steps were being taken to reorganize the Dept. Two months had passed and early this year His Excellency in the same speech again told the house that the new shape of things planned for the Dept would be placed before that session of the House.

That was some 18 months ago and the whole country is yet waiting to see the new look. Are we to hear at the next meeting of the House that the reorganization is yet to come? and what exactly are the factors which make that apparently simple operation so difficult to perform. Has the Government some ugly skeleton in cupboard which it is anxious to keep from the Public? We are still waiting.
