**WESTERN REGIONAL GOVERNMENT**  
**SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Western Regional Government will be awarding a further one hundred scholarships this year to applicants of Western Origin. They will be tenable at institutions in Nigeria commencing from the 1955-56 Session and will generally be tenable at Colleges and institutions abroad commencing from the Session 1956-57. Students already studying at institutions abroad however, may, depending upon the recommendations of the Scholarship Board, have their awards made tenable from an earlier date.

**2. The numbers and types of awards will be as follows:-**

Agricultural Degree Courses	18
Forestry	4
Medical	16
Dentistry	6
Science & Maths.	30
Engineering	15
Veterinary	5
Survey Courses (see para. 3 below)	6

3. The six scholarships for survey courses are being offered only to members of the Survey Department of the Western Region, and separate instructions in regard to these awards will be circularised Departmentally. The instructions given below do not apply to these six awards.

4. Only persons of Western Origin will be eligible for awards.

5. Applications for scholarships may be made by candidates of either sex, preference normally being given those candidates under thirty years of age.

6. The minimum qualification required from any applicant is Grade II Cambridge School Certificate with exemption from London Matriculation. Applicants holding only a Grade III Cambridge School Certificate or who have obtained exemption from London Matriculation on basis of such a certificate will not be considered for an award.

7. Candidates wishing to proceed to University College, Ibadan or to the Nigerian College of Arts, Science and Technology, to undertake courses of study which are available there must apply direct to the College Authorities to sit for examination in accordance with the procedure prescribed and will not be eligible for awards unless they have been accepted for entry by the College Authorities.

8. Applicants applying for courses of Study at institutions outside Nigeria should ensure that their academic qualification are sufficient to enable them to be placed in suitable institutions to undertake degree courses as soon as admitted as scholarships abroad will not be offered for studies up to General Certificate of Education (Advanced Level) or equivalent examinations.

9. All applications for scholarships must be completed in duplicate on the prescribed forms which may be obtained from:-

- All Provincial Education Offices in the Western Region;
- The Secretary to the Scholarship Board, Ministry of Education, Ibadan;
- The Commissioner for the Western Region, 18, Grosvenor Gardens, London, S.W.1;
- The Nigerian Liaison Officer, 226 Dupont Circle Building, Washington, D.C.6.

10. Application forms must be returned direct to the Secretary of the Scholarship Board, Ministry of Education, Western Region, Ibadan, through the Heads of Departments in the case of Government employees, and through Principals of Schools or Colleges or through employers as appropriate in all other cases and should be

received NOT LATER THAN THE 14th JULY 1955.

11. Central or Regional Ministers must not be given as referees, and applicants who resort to canvassing will be disqualified.

12. Successful candidates will be required to enter into a bond to serve the Western Regional Government for a specified period of time after the successful completion of their courses of study.

### PILGRIMAGE ARRANGEMENT

THE FOLLOWING EXTRACT FROM THE SUDAN GOVERNMENT'S CIRCULAR ON PILGRIMAGE ARRANGEMENTS FOR 1955 IS PUBLISHED FOR INFORMATION

#### MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS

Each Pilgrim must have the following inoculations and vaccination certified on the International Form of Immunisation Certificate:

Vaccination against Smallpox at least two weeks and not more than 3 years old.

Inoculation against Yellow Fever at least 10 days and not more than 4 years old.

Inoculation against Cholera at least 6 days and not more than 6 months old.

#### FINANCE

Foreign Pilgrims entering the Sudan will be required to produce evidence either that they have prepaid their Sudan Government and Saudi Arabian Government dues and deposits and have sufficient cash to pay their expenses to Suakin (estimated at £E.10 from Geneva) or that they have sufficient money either in cash or in the form of bankers drafts negotiable in the Sudan to meet these charges.

If the pilgrim carries cash to meet these expenses he will be required to deposit in the Government chest at Geneva the following amounts against receipt, which amounts will be withdrawable on arrival in Suakin.

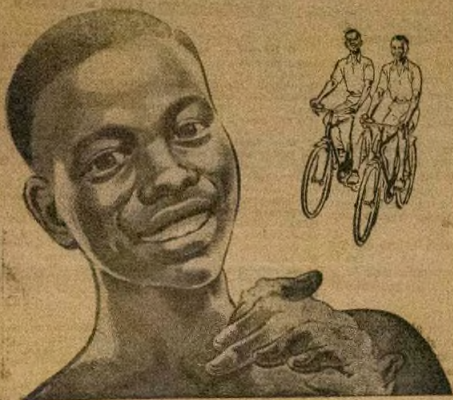

His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government will attend the ceremonial parade, which will take place on the Race Course at 8 a.m. on Thursday the 9th of June, in celebration of the Official Birthday of Her Majesty the Queen. Officers attend the ceremony in either of the stands who are entitled to wear uniform should do so. Civilians are requested to wear the medals to which they are entitled.

2. There will be a limited number of reserved seats in the Prince of Wales Stand for members of the Council of Ministers, officials and leading members of the public, to whom invitations will be sent. Admission will be by white tickets, which be issued by the Chief Administrative Officer.

3. Seats will also be reserved in the Grand Stand for officials and leading members of the public who are not accommodated in the Prince of Wales Stand. Admission to these seats will be by GREEN ticket, which will be issued by the Chief Administrative Officer.

4. Any tickets surplus to official requirements in the Grand Stand will be available to the general public on application at the Office of the Chief Administrative Officer on Wednesday the 8th of June between 8 and 9 a.m. THERE WILL BE NO ADMISSION TO THE PRINCE OF WALES STAND OR THE GRAND STAND EXCEPT BY TICKET.

- 5. All those who do not obtain tickets will be accommodated round the ropes enclosing the Parade Ground.
- 6. Spectators must be in their places by 7.40 a.m.
- 7. The attention of all car owners is drawn to the following traffic arrangements:-

- (1) Between 7 a.m. and 8 a.m. Race Course Road between Molony Street and the junction of Oskan Road with Force Road will be closed to traffic.
- (2) Between 7 a.m. and 9 a.m. the road leading towards the Grand Stand from the junction of Onikan Road with Force Road will be closed to traffic going in the direction of the Colonial Church.
- (3) The only approach to the Stands will be through the directies of the Colonial Church.

Arrivals: There will be two Car Parks:-

Park A. Race Course Paddock, With overflow (if necessary) on to the road leading from the Grand Stand to Force Road. This park is for use by vehicles which have a white car label affixed to the windscreen.  
Park B. ON THE RACE COURSE Opposite the Colonial Church, with overflow (if necessary) in Campbell Street. This park is for use by vehicles which have a green car label affixed to the windscreen.

Departure:

Vehicles from Park A will leave via Force or Paddock Roads. Vehicles from Park B will leave via Cable Street, Broad Street or King's College Road.  
GENERAL ADVICE: To assist the Police and to avoid unnecessary delay, holders of white and green car labels are requested to affix the label on the left (near) side of the windscreen of their vehicles.

- 9. Should it be decided that owing to bad weather the parade must be postponed, and announcement will be made in the national programme of the Nigerian Broadcasting Service at 6.45, 7 and 7.15 a.m. on Thursday the 9th of June, if postponed, the parade will take place at 5 p.m. the same day.
