WESTERN REGION PRODUCTION DEVELOPMENT BOARD

WORK IN PROGRESS

In the eleven articles we have published until now, we have told you not only something about our Headquarters, but also have reported on the large agricultural schemes which are now nearing completion; the two factories and the Rest House which are now in operation and also we have given you advance information of the new enterprises which we are thinking about.

In addition to these projects we have a number which have already been started upon but which will not reach completion for a year or two. This, the last of our present articles, is to tell you something about those enterprises.

COCOA

As we have told you, the Board's policy concerning cocoa is to improve the standard of the trees and the crop and this we are achieving by modern methods of farming and with the use of the best and highest yielding planting material. We have already told you of the 3,500 acres of cocoa which we are growing at Apojo. In addition, we have two large plantations under way, one at Odo Akure and the other at Ilesha. Both these plantations were started in 1955. In order to be able to achieve the heavy planting programme we have planned, large nurseries are being maintained at both Akure and Ilesha which carry a total of 150,000 cocoa seedlings in pods. Many of these are of the Amazon type which as we have stated before, combines a quick rate of growth with an amazingly high yield. In all we have planned to plant 3,500 acres at these two plantations and by the time they are completed, we would have spent over £450,000.

In the meantime, the soils Division of the Department of Agriculture is mapping other areas of our Region which are suitable for cocoa and the Board is carefully following the progress with interest in order to obtain land

found to be suitable for further cocoa estates. We hope that within a few years this Region will be able to boast of several up-to-date and well-managed cocoa estates covering several thousands of acres of land with economical methods of production and high quality seed. These plantations should be very profitable indeed. At the same time, they will enable us to employ many people in the Region who otherwise might be unemployed.

RUBBER

We have already told you about our 4,000-acre Rubber plantation at Urhoinigbe. Work has also been started on an even larger plantation at Araromi where we have planned a 6,000 acre plantation which when complete with a Processing Factory, office buildings and houses for the workers, will have cost us £1,300,000. With the experience of establishing the Urhoinigbe plantation behind us, we have an ambitious planting programme for this estate. We hope to plant 2,000 acres this year and 3,000 acres in 1957. As is the usual Board policy with regard to large plantations, we plan to provide for the workers modern villages and first-class facilities.

As is the case with cocoa, we are taking advantage of the work done by the soils Division of the Department of Agriculture and are keeping in close touch with the possibility of establishing further rubber plantations in the Region.

PINEAPPLE

The Board's activities with regard to pineapple

arises only because we want to feed the Lafia Canning Factory until there is sufficient citrus fruit to meet the requirements of the factory. We have 282 acres in plantations, but we also grow pineapples as intercrops and buy them from the local farmers.

PARTNERSHIP SCHEMES

When we published our article on partnership schemes, it was intended to interest the people in the Region in the benefit which would be obtained if they could offer land which could be usefully developed by the Board. We may say that letters are still coming in in answer to that article. We hope that the people looked carefully at the list we gave of the partnerships which we had already started upon. If so, you would have seen that they covered such crops as oil palms, cocoa, citrus and coffee. In deciding upon future partnerships, the Board will be guided by what crop the land is most suitable for and, naturally, whether that crop is beneficial to our Region.

A SUMMING UP

We started this series of articles with a motto "Never Count Your Chickens Before They Are Hatched". Our chickens are only just beginning to hatch but we already have a number to count. Nigerian Rubber, for instance, is now recognised as high grade on the London Market, while canned Nigerian grapefruit fetches higher price than a similar canned fruit from any other part of the world. We are providing work for over 7,000 people directly quite apart from the contractors who are helping us with our

building work and those who are employed on road construction. Those who secured early scholarships from the Board are beginning to come home trained and qualified and their numbers will increase over the next year and most of all we are proving to the people that with careful selection of material and scientific methods of production this Region can economically grow a wide variety of crops in demand here and overseas.

In the plantations already started upon, we will grow over 13,000 acres of oil palms, 10,000 acres of rubber, over 6,000 acres of cocoa, nearly 2,000 acres of citrus, over 1,000 acres of coffee, 1,000 acres of cashew as well as 43,500 acres set aside for our cattle ranch. This plantations when complete with the most modern equipment, fine buildings and factories, will costs over £6 million.

On the industrial side, we have already erected and are operating a canning factory, a rubber processing factory and catering rest-house which, altogether, have cost over £600,000 and we must not forget to mention the twenty-three pioneer oil mills which we have erected in various parts of the Region in order to make better use of the valuable palm-kernels grown by local farmers and produce the special grade oil rather than the former inferior oil produced by old-fashioned methods.

We have set aside over £2,500,000 for development of the Region including the construction and tarring of roads and feeder roads. We have also earned £400,000 for scholarships.

We think this is quite a good achievement for the five years that the Board has been actively in operation but that you can judge for yourselves.


