INVITATION TO TENDER

1. Tenders are invited by the Nigerian Ports Authority for the purchase of such scrap materials as the Authority may offer for disposal (with the exception of any items which may be separately offered for sale) during the period 1st January, 1963, to 30th June, 1963, in Apapa Dockyard, Apapa Quays, Customs Quay or any other particular point where the Authority may have scrap metal for disposal in the Lagos or Apapa area.

2. A copy of the tender form may be obtained from the Secretary to the Authority, 216, Broad Street, Lagos, on payment of a deposit of £5 to the Authority's Cashier, Accounts Department, Apapa Quays. The completed tender form should thereafter be returned to the Secretary, in a sealed envelope marked "CONFIDENTIAL-TENDER FOR SCRAP" so as to reach him not later than Monday, January 14th, 1963.

3. The deposit of £5 will not be refunded in any event to any tenderer who upon being advised of the acceptance of his tender, fails to pay for and to remove the materials made available.

4. Tenderers are warned that scrap available for disposal may comprise both ferrous and non-ferrous materials although it is expected that most of the materials will be ferrous.

5. During the six-month period indicated, the successful tenderer will be required to remove at his own expense, whatever scrap is made available for sale (with the exception mentioned above) within 7 days of being notified to do so. He will also be required to make necessary arrangements at his expense for all such scrap to be weighed in the presence of a representative of the Authority before being removed.

Wireless and Television Licences

All owners of wireless and television sets are reminded that the current licences will expire on the 31st December, 1962 and will then require renewal for the year 1963. A licence issued in respect of a residential radio set does not cover a set installed in the licensee's motor vehicle and any person who has a set in both his residence and his motor vehicle requires two separate licences. A wireless licence costs 10/- for a year and a television licence (which covers the use of a wireless as well as a television set) £2.10.- for a year. These licences may be purchased at all Post Offices and at the larger Postal Agencies.

It is an offence under the Wireless Telegraphy Act to operate a set without a licence and offenders are liable to a fine of £50.

The wireless and Television Licence Inspectors of the Ministry of Communications will shortly be undertaking house-to-house inspections of licences. The Ministry is anxious to inconvenience owners of sets as little as possible and it therefore urges them to have their licences readily available for inspection. It should be noted, however, that the Ministry's Inspectors are not authorised to collect licence fees or issue licences.

The Regulations under the Wireless Telegraphy Ordinance require that at the time of purchase of a wireless or television set the purchaser must produce a valid current licence to the dealer. In their own interest, dealers must insist on this before any sets are given out on sale.

West African Students Move Into New London University Hostel

LONDON—

Twelve West African students, eight from Nigeria and four from Ghana, are among the first to take up residence in London University's newest hostel which opens its doors next week.

Commonwealth Hall, now nearing completion, will be the most modern of London University's many hostels, with study bedrooms for 400 students, a library, squash courts, canteen, a billiards room

and common rooms.

Two hundred and fifty young men from all over the world will be moving into the hostel next week, including some post-graduate research students. With the West Africans

will be students from India, Pakistan, America, Canada, Cuba, Germany and the Soviet Union.

"Commonwealth Hall is not planned only for students from overseas but we shall try to keep a balance between the different countries represented and also the different colleges at which they

are studying," said a member of the staff.

"All the rooms will not be completed immediately but when the building is completed we hope it will go a long way towards alleviating the accommodation problem for students in London".

New Appointment For Sir Philip Rogers

LAGOS—Sir Philip Rogers, one of the first two commercial members of the postwar Nigerian Legislative Council will shortly take up a new appointment as Chairman of the Tobacco Manufacturers Standing Committee in the United Kingdom.

Sir Philip, who for the past 11 years has been Chairman of East African Tobacco Company Limited spent 18 years in Nigeria in the tobacco industry.

As Factory Manager he established Nigeria's first experimental cigarette factory in a disused cotton ginnery at Oshogbo in 1935. Two years later he took charge of the then British American Tobacco Company's (now Nigerian Tobacco Company's) new cigarette factory at Ibadan.

He was President of the of the Lagos Chamber of Commerce in 1948 and 1950 and from 1947 to 1951 served as a member of the Legislative Council.

Purchase Tax Cuts In Britain

London—British purchase tax of 45 per cent on various consumer goods has been cut to 25 per cent, as from yesterday, the British Chancellor of the Exchequer Mr. Reginald Maudling has announced in London.

The new measure will have the effect of stimulating production and exports.

Items affected are mainly television and wireless sets, gramophones, perfumery and cosmetics. Now there will be only three rates of purchase tax, the standard rate of 25 per cent and

the two lower rates of 15 and 10 per cent.

In his announcement, the Chancellor said that the recent reduction in the purchase tax on motor cars from 45 to 25 per cent was made in recognition of the importance of the industry to exports, investment and to the economy generally, and he did not now consider there was any justification for continuing the exceptionally high level of 45 per cent on remaining items such as television sets etc.
