

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS

#### WESTERN REGION. CLAIMS AND OBJECTIONS.

All persons who registered in the Western Region as electors during November, 1955, should between the 1st and 16th of January, 1956, visit the registration Offices at which they registered. There they will be able to examine their Preliminary List of Electors. The Preliminary List for each Registration Area will be on display at the Registration Office for each Registration Area for the period the 1st to 16th of January, 1956. These offices will be open from 3.30 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. on each of these days except for Sundays and public Holidays.

2. If any person who is qualified wishes to make a claim for registration or transfer or to submit an objection this must be done on the appropriate form 'B', 'C' or 'D', as specified in the Second Schedule to the Parliamentary and Local Government Electoral Regulations, 1955.

(i) Form 'B' will be used by a person who does not find his/her name in the Preliminary List of Electors, even though he/she completed and handed in at the correct Registration Office in November, 1955, an application form for registration (Form 'A').

(ii) Form 'C' will be used by a person who finds that he/her name is shown in the Preliminary List in a ward other than that in which he/she applied to be registered. Such a person will be able to apply for transfer to the correct Ward by means of Form 'C'.

(iii) Form 'D' will be used by persons who wish to give notice of objection to a name in the Preliminary List.

A copy of each of these forms can be obtained from any registration Office. Also, copies of these forms prepared by private individuals or political Parties which are identical with Forms 'B', 'C' and 'D' shown in the Second Schedule of the Regulations may be used. Party headquarters are being given, on application, large quantities of forms 'B', 'C' and 'D' for distribution to their representatives throughout the Western Region. For this reason Assistant Registration Officers have been instructed only to issue one copy of any Form to individual applicants.

#### (i) FORMS 'B'

3. Completed copies of the form 'B' can be delivered at the Registration Office for the registration area in which the original claim for registration was made between 3.30 p.m. and 5.30 p.m. any day, except Sundays and Public Holidays, between the 1st and 16th January, 1956. They can also be delivered to the Registration Officer in charge of the constituency concerned during his normal hours of business on or before the 16th January 1956.

#### (ii) FORMS 'C' AND 'D'

Completed copies of Forms 'C' and 'D' can only be delivered during the normal hours of Public business to the Registration Officer in Charge of the constituency concerned between the 1st and 16th January, 1956.

#### (iii) LATE DELIVERY - FORMS 'B', 'C' AND 'D'

Any completed Claim and Objection forms received by an Assistant Registration Officer (in the case of Form 'B' only), or by the Registration Officer in charge of the constituency, after 5.30 p.m. on the 16th of January, 1956, will NOT be accepted.

4. As soon as possible after the 16th of January, 1956, Registration Officers will publish by means of public notices in the Local government council Wards concerned, the names and addresses of all persons there who are the subject of a claim or an objection, the names and addresses of the persons who have lodged such claims or objections, and the time and place at which these claims and objections will be determined.

5. All claims and objections will be heard in public. If any of the persons involved fail to appear at the time and place stated in the appropriate public notice, the claim or objection will be determined in their absence. For this reason it is important that the public should study carefully all public notices which appear in each Local government council Ward during January, 1956.

6. The public is reminded that the making of a false statement by a claimant or objector in relation to his/her claim/objection (even if it is not made on oath) is an offence against the Parliamentary and Local Government Electoral Regulations, 1955, which is punishable by imprisonment for up to one year. Also, that the making of false statements on oath may be perjury, the maximum punishment for which is fourteen years imprisonment.
