Yellow Fever and Small Pox Vaccinations and other Inoculations for Persons Intending to Travel by Air

Intending passengers by air from Nigeria to destinations outside West Africa must carry valid International Certificate of Vaccination against Yellow Fever and Smallpox.

YELLOW FEVER
In the case of inoculation against Yellow Fever for the first time, the premises for inoculation are not less than 10 DAYS before departure...
PROVIDED THAT evidence of an inoculation, given not more than FOUR YEARS previously, is produced by the inoculating OFFICER...

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT
As the stocks in Nigeria of Yellow Fever Vaccine have become dangerously low and as new stocks are not expected for some considerable time, it has been found necessary to RESTRICT THE GIVING OF YELLOW FEVER INOCULATIONS.

As from 1st January, 1951, Yellow Fever inoculations will be given only to persons who urgently require them for the purpose of air travel. Persons travelling overseas by sea are strongly advised to obtain their inoculations, or re-inoculations while overseas before returning to Nigeria.

Yellow Fever inoculations of persons in the Lagos area will be given only in the BATHROLOGY DEPT. BROAD STREET, LAGOS, EACH SATURDAY MORNING AT 09.30 O'CLOCK. Only those persons who are inoculated who have, by letter or telephone, arranged for their inoculations with the Pathologist, Lagos, (Tel. Lagos 332) at least 24 hours before the time of inoculation.

SMALLPOX
Vaccination against smallpox should be performed at least one week prior to departure, as the second part of the International Certificate requires that the vaccination site should be inspected by the Vaccinating Officer on the fifth day after vaccination. The certificate is not valid for more than 3 years from the date of issue.

In the case of re-vaccination, the passengers should report to the Vaccination Officer on the 2nd day after vaccination.

Inoculations in the Lagos area are performed at the HEALTH OFFICE, BROAD STREET, LAGOS, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 11.30 noon daily, (except Sunday and at the PORT HEALTH OFFICE, Lagos, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 a.m. daily except Sunday).

OTHER INOCULATIONS
Inoculations against Cholera, Typhus and Plague may be obtained by request to the Pathologist (C. Pathology Department, Lagos, Tel. Lagos 332) or by application to any Sanitary Medical Officer.
