Public Notice

GOVERNOR-GENERAL'S OFFICE, LAGOS, NOVEMBER, 1957. The Fiscal Commission.

The Fiscal Commission returned to the United Kingdom on the 16th November, 1957 after a preliminary visit to Nigeria during which the Commission visited the Federal capital and the capitals of the Western and the Southern Provinces.

The Commission will return to Nigeria in late March, 1958, for a period of some six weeks, and will be preceded in January by the Adviser on Indirect Taxation. All persons, public and private, wishing to make representations to the Fiscal Commission are invited to submit them by way of memoranda (six copies of each) to the Joint Secretaries, Fiscal Commission, Governor-General's Office, Lagos. Memoranda should reach this address by the 31st December, 1957, or the latest, and they should only deal with matters falling within the terms of reference of the Fiscal Commission, which are set out in paragraph 57 of the Report by the Nigeria Constitutional Committee, 1957, (obtainable from the Federal Government Printer, price 1s. 0d.)

- 1. Memoranda should deal only with one or more of the following subjects:
 - (a) The division of the powers to levy Income Tax, Direct Taxes and Indirect Taxes between the Governments of the Federation, and the appropriate distribution of the revenue from such taxes between the Federal and Regional Governments.
 - (b) The Fiscal arrangements most appropriate for the Southern Provinces.
 - (c) The subject of public arrangements for the introduction of land taxes, Governmental borrowing and capital issues.

Under the terms of reference the Commission cannot take any account of the possibility of the establishment of a new State or States as a result of the recommendations of the Advisory Commission. It is, therefore, precluded from considering any representations which envisage the establishment of any such new States.

2. The contents of the memoranda which are submitted, the Fiscal Commission will decide whether it wishes to hear and address from any of those who have submitted written representations.

3. All memoranda should bear the name and address of the proposer.
