



VACANCY - CHIEF DRAUGHSMAN (INSTRUCTOR)

Nigerian Ports Authority has, in its Engineering Department, a vacancy for Chief Draughtsman (Instructor) for which applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates should have had at least ten years experience in a Senior position of either Deputy Chief Draughtsman or Chief Draughtsman or Ch of Draughtsman in a reputable Drawing Office; must be fully conversant with the day to day running of a Drawing Office. Knowledge of reinforced concrete and structural steel work design, and detailing, and building construction is essential. A recognised Engineering qualification will be an advantage.

DUTIES:

The successful candidate will be in charge of the training of indigenous Draughtsmen, and will be solely responsible for the running of the Authority's Drawing Office. He will be responsible to the Deputy Chief engineer.

SALARY SCALE:

The salary scale for the post is the Authority's Scale 4 (b) - £1350/1815 per annum, if an indigenous candidate is appointed. In the case of an Expatriate, the appointment will be on contract at a Consolidated salary of between £1650 and £2115 per annum. First tour in either case will be on probation.
