Edo College, Benin—Entrance Examination, 1951

- The Entrance and Scholarship Examination for admission to Edo College in January, 1952, will be held on 14th April, 1951.
- There will be centres at Agbot, Akure, Benin, Irua and Warri. Other centres will be arranged as may be deemed necessary.
- Papers will be set in English, Arithmetic and General Knowledge.
- Candidates must be attending Recognised Senior Primary Schools. They should apply to their Headmasters who should forward lists of candidates to the Provincial Education Officer. Candidates should not apply to the Principal or Provincial Education Officer direct.
- Applications must be in the office of the Education Officer not later than 20th February, 1951. No entries will be accepted after this date.
- There will be an Entrance Fee of 2/-. Therefore every application must be accompanied by a Treasury Receipt of 2/-.
- Applications will not be accepted from boys below standard V.
- Candidates should not be more than thirteen and half years of age of 1st January, 1952. Where no birth certificate exists candidates will be judged on general physical development.
- About fifty candidates will be selected for interview at Benin later in the year.
- Six Government Scholarships giving board and tuition will be awarded to candidates on merit.
- Tuition and Boarding fees £21 per annum (payable termially in advance in three instalments of £7). Books, clothes, games £5 per annum £3 payable in January and £2 in June.
- Only Scholarship winners and candidates being offered admission will be informed. A list of successful candidates will be published in the daily papers.
- The Principal cannot enter into any correspondence regarding the rejection of any candidate.

The attention of the public is directed to Regulation H (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation 29 of 1948 which reads:-
(1) "If any person to whom a licence has been issued in accordance with this regulation shall satisfy the Licensing Authority that the vehicle in respect of which the licence has been issued will not be used in Nigeria during the unexpired portion of the period of the currency of the licence, the Licensing Authority may refund to such person a portion of the fee paid for such licence in accordance with Part IV of the Second Schedule."
