West African Work British Paint Factory For Leprosy In Nigeria

LONDON—Doctors and research workers from West and East Africa and from London will tell the story of their work in helping the fight against leprosy and the latest developments towards stamping out the disease in a special B.B.C radio programme broadcast to many parts of the world in the General Overseas Service

with Dr N Fraser, Medical Secretary of the "Mission to Lepers" in London who has recently returned from a visit to East Africa, Dr R G Cechrane, Adviser on Leprosy to the Ministry of Health in London and representatives of Britain's Medical Research Council, where important new work is being done.

LONDON—A British firm is to build a new paint factory in Nigeria which will help to meet Nigeria's demands for industrial and domestic paints and will eventually produce paints for export to other West African countries.

Pinehin Johnson and Associates, of London (a subsidiary of Gourauds Limited) will build a factory in Eastern Nigeria at Trans-Amadi. The head office will be near to Port Harcourt and production will start in 1965.

Dr S G Brown, Director of the Leprosy Research Unit at Umuahia, Eastern Nigeria, will be among those taking part, together

The programme will be broadcast on Tuesday April 14 at 4.15 p.m. and on Wednesday April 15 at 9.45 p.m.

'As well as building the factory,' a spokesman for the firm said recently, 'we shall also train Nigerians to take over key posts at plant, instruction in technical and administrative matters will be undertaken both in Nigeria and Britain.'

'The founding capital will be £100,000. Initially fifty employees will be recruited though the number will greatly increase in time, the firm's spokesman added.


The plant, which is to have the full technical backing of the firm's British factories, will produce 'Gairol' decorative paints and "Red Hand" marine paints. The factory will be administered under the control of a new company registered in Port Harcourt and named Pinehin Johnson and Associates (West Africa) Limited.

Pinehin Johnson have had extensive export connections with Nigeria for many years and the decision to build a factory in Nigeria came as a result of increased demand for paint by industrial users. The new factory will be the first the firm has launched in Africa, and the second outside Britain; one factory has already been built in India.





BBC BOOK REVIEW

Conflict Of Cultures

"Some time ago," said Ibrahim Taher in a recent BBC African Service broadcast, "I read a book about the pygmies of the equatorial forests of Africa. It was objective and showed a warmth and a loving understanding of the pygmy without any of the starchy-eyed sentimentality or the condescension that sometimes affects the writing of many European writers of African peoples."

Now the author of that book, Colin Turnbull, had written another book called "The Lonely African," and Ibrahim Taher reviewed in the BBC African Service programme A BOOK FOR TODAY. "The loneliness of the African which concerns Mr. Turnbull," he said, "is that produced by alienation from the traditional way of life through contact with European ways and education, and rejection by the very white man who has sought to stamp the African with a European image."

The author chose a number of individuals from various parts of Africa, each in conflict with a different aspect of his problem. There was the servant Masoudi, a Northern Rhodesian, whose European master sent him to a mission school and made a clerk of him. When Masoudi returned to his tribe with his new way, they were all suspicious of him, and finding a wife proved impossible. There were the old chiefs who found that the younger generation would not respond to the old loyalties. There were the politicians and educated civil servants who worked

according to new principles and new ideas, but found that in both private and public life the old traditions and values exercised a dominating influence. (Cont'd on page eight)


