Award of Government Scholarships And Bursaries 1952-53.

Government proposes to offer (subject to the provisions of necessary funds by the Legislature) further bursaries and scholarships to become available in the years 1952 and 1953...

1. The courses for which awards will be made will include (a) General degree courses and (b) Education including Teacher Training College, and (c) Professional courses in Agriculture, Engineering, Forestry, Medical and Veterinary degrees.

It is proposed to make awards to suitable candidates to enable them to obtain qualifications for the Public Service...

2. Scholarships and bursary awards are primarily intended to assist applicants with the professional qualifications necessary for appointment to the Public Service...

3. Applications for awards will be accepted from candidates of either sex, of whatever profession, calling or occupation, preference being given to those under thirty years of age...

4. Candidates for scholarships must possess the minimum educational qualifications required by the institution at which the course will be taken...

5. The majority of awards will be for courses now available at the University College, Ibadan...

6. Applications by serving Government officers for the training courses recommended in paragraph 2 (c) of the Government Commission Report...

7. All awards will be made by His Excellency the Governor on the recommendation of the Central Public Service Board...

8. All applications for scholarships and bursaries must be completed in duplicate on the prescribed form...

9. Failure to comply with any of these instructions may result in the rejection of a candidate's application.

With reference to the speech made in Legislative Council on Friday, 4th August, by the Financial Secretary regarding Government's intention to review the Nigerian salary structure, it is desired to explain for the information of serving officers the steps which will be taken to carry out this review.

1. It was the intention of Sir Walter Huggins, in his Report to the Commission on the Civil Service of British West Africa, to revise a salary structure which would provide stability over a period of at least five years. Although many gradations in the Sir Walter Huggins's proposals have been made, the salary scales and structure which his report introduced have remained substantially unaltered...

2. Government's intention to review the structure of a new salary structure which will include an intended to grade. The outline will be prepared in the Nigerian Secretariat in consultation with Regional Authorities and Heads of Departments...

3. Government's intention is primarily to review the salary structure and to find conditions of service. It is not intended to carry out a complete relative reposition, although as noted in Legislative Council, it is proposed to consolidate the basic salary, the present temporary additions to rate of pay...

4. Government proposes to begin the review immediately. It will, however, be appreciated that an operation of this magnitude must take many months to complete. Even after a new salary structure has been approved in principle by the Legislative Council, several months of expert work will be required to set it into effect...

Three Nigerians Win American Grants

The American Consulate General announced that three Nigerians, graduates of American colleges, have been awarded United States Government Grants through the Department of State's student exchange programme.

The grants, administered by the Department of State in cooperation with the Institute of International Education, have been awarded to Laywola Ade-doyin Adedeji, Lagos; Simon Obi Anokwe of Ukpou, Onitsha Province, and Hiepaka Adedunmola Oluwasanmi of Ipetu-Ipetu.

The grant to Mr Adedeji, a graduate of Southwestern College in Winfield, Kansas, covers the full cost of tuition and fees, books, maintenance, health insurance as well as return travel from New York to Nigeria. He will study toward a graduate degree in education at the University of Illinois.

A similar grant has been made to Mr Anokwe, a graduate of St. John's University in Brooklyn, New York, who will study toward an advanced degree in journalism at Columbia University. Mr Oluwasanmi, an honou... graduate of Morehouse College, Atlanta, Georgia, will study toward a graduate degree in economics at Harvard University with the assistance of a grant covering costs of tuition and fees, maintenance and books.

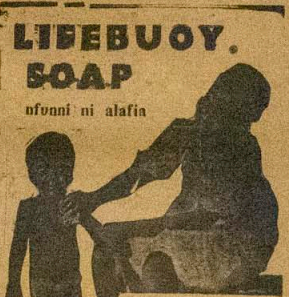

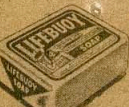
