



British Premier Welcomes Tanganyika Zanzibar Merger

LONDON—The British Prime Minister Sir Alec Douglas-Hume has congratulated the leaders of Tanganyika and Zanzibar on their "wise initiative" in merging the two countries into one state.

Sir Alec has sent the following message to President Nyerere of Tanganyika (full text): May I warmly congratulate you and Vice-President Karume on your wise initiative in creating the Union of Tanganyika and Zanzibar. I send you my sincere good wishes for the future happiness and prosperity of Tanganyika and Zanzibar in your new partner ship.

A similar message was also sent to Vice-President Karume of Zanzibar.

BBC 'On New Way To Learn English'

The new system of learning English spelling that is now being developed in Britain will eventually be introduced to African educationalists. This news was given in a BBC broadcast by Sir James Purman, M.P. who is the leader of this new spelling movement.

Speaking on the BBC African service programme WORLD HORIZONS Sir James said that the system was already being taught in Australia, Canada, the United States and other English-speaking countries. As soon as it gets going, I shall take up the question of helping people in Africa and Asia. I think everywhere where the English language is being learnt as a second language, it will help enormously.

Sir James outlined the hardship would be caused by a period of uncertainty because there was no difficulty whatever in transition. There is no uncertainty about it at all. It literally takes only one minute for children, once they've become fluent readers in the Initial Teaching Alphabet to become fluent readers of ordinary books. We've already had 1,500 children do this they just put down one book and pick up another.

This method of teaching was successful with both children and adults. And so far as learning English as a second language is concerned said Sir James of course it will be a tremendous development for adult education. But only—he said more generally—can it go over to the extent of even more education. This is to say the learning of English as a reading and writing as a second language.

The ITA was only a temporary phase, learning English. It is designed, Sir James explained, to lead up to the traditional English alphabet with its present 26 letters and twenty six letters, and the spelling that is used in books on secondary school room. Adults and teenagers feared that this would
