# New Drug For Sleeping Sickness

## BENEFIT FOR WEST AFRICA

**GENEVA**—Sleeping sickness, which begins with fever and headaches, is remarkable because of the wastage and somnolence that characterize its later stages. Probably because of the dramatic nature of these symptoms, it is one of the continent's oldest recorded diseases, having been mentioned in the writings of Arab historians of the 14th century.

The ancestral home of sleeping sickness appears to have been West Africa and attempts to open up the continent probably helped to spread the disease. In spite of the difficulties it caused explorers, missionaries and traders, many of them battled their way through infested country and carried sleeping sickness into areas where it previously had been unknown.

### New Drugs

Drugs are now being successfully used to prevent and treat sleeping sickness in man and livestock and notable achievements have been recorded in contro-

lling the disease by this means in West African territories and in the Sudan. Armed with modern drugs, it seems that disastrous epidemics are a thing of the past, providing that facilities are available for reaching people in time.

Prevention and treatment of sleeping sickness with drugs have limitations however. The appearance of drug-resistant strains and the relatively great administrative difficulties of reaching large numbers of people or cattle at frequent intervals have made it virtually impossible, particularly in dealing with nomadic tribes, to think of eradicating sleeping sickness by this means alone.

### International

Sleeping sickness may well disappear as a social condition improves, nomads are settled and more land is brought under cultivation. But these improvements may not come about until the disease is sufficiently subjugated to allow the needed farming that is necessary to provide protein foods required for a energetic society. The cycle has been broken in several areas by eradicating the fly, by killing game and by bush clearing. Vaccination if successful would, of course, be a great advance. This aspect is under investigation.

### Disease

In spite of demonstrable progress, sleeping sickness still is a threat in Africa. Until the developing countries have organized their health and other services and until they have the

necessary trained personnel and money, it will be the duty of international agencies to help in every way possible. The tsetse fly does not recognize political boundaries and only international help can prevent the situation from becoming dangerous.

International interest in trypanosomiasis dates back to the League of Nations. The first international conference was held in London, in 1925, and the second, in Paris, in 1928. The recommendations of these conferences indicate that even then the importance of the man, animal, fly relationship was fully appreciated.
