2,158 West African Students In Britain

According to an official distribution list published in London last week, 2,158 West African students in the United Kingdom. Although this number includes Government, private and private students, it is known that there are 1,000 additional non-graduate private students in the United Kingdom from West Africa.

The official list shows a total of 147 Government students from West Africa and 1,617 private students, and gives the following total of 1,154 students in Britain: the Gold Coast 287, Sierra Leone 287 and the Gambia 28.

Students at Government and non-graduate schools are 721 students.

Gambia 4, Gold Coast 522, Nigeria 106, Sierra Leone 22, and 141 private students (Gambia 5, Gold Coast 54, Nigeria 307 and Sierra Leone 27). At Colleges and Technical and Training Schools are 180 students (Gambia 3, Gold Coast 105, Nigeria 125, Sierra Leone 14) and 537 private students (Gambia 7, Gold Coast 123, Nigeria 165, Sierra Leone 147, and 260 private students).

Of the 1,617 private students, 144 are at 110 private schools in Britain. The rest are 1,473 private students, and 462 private students in Gambia five public schools. Sierra Leone 226. Nigerian Girl Guides To Visit Britain

Two representatives of the Girl Guides Association of Nigeria will participate in the International Camp of the Girl Guides of Great Britain in August. The names of the two girls, who were announced as follows: 14-year-old Betsy Akpan will represent the Eastern Region, of Rivers, and 16-year-old Victoria Mavwa will represent the Western Region. They will hold the rank of Scout and Guide.

The two Guides will leave Nigeria on July 28th and return on September 24th.

They are taking with them full Nigerian national flags, as well as the International Camp of the Girl Guides of Great Britain in August. They will participate in camp activities and will probably perform Nigerian dances and play Nigerian traditional music. They are also planning to make a Nigerian dish for the camp. It will probably be for the first time that the two girls will represent Nigeria in the camp. They will be accompanied by a Nigerian Girl Guide leader (read a palm leaf) in the camp. The Nigerian Girl Guides will also wish girls from every province when getting guides and they will be giving much valuable information on Girl Guide training.
