

# Nigeria Takes Up Cable And Wireless

LONDON—Another partnership venture between Nigeria and Britain was launched in London, yesterday, when an agreement was signed by the Nigerian Federal Minister of Communications, Mr. Olu-Akinfosile and Sir John Macpherson, chairman of Cable and Wireless Ltd., and a former Governor of Nigeria. "An example of practical co-operation in the modern and developing Commonwealth," was how they described it.

Also present at the signing ceremony were Mr. T. O. S. Benson, Nigerian Minister of Information, and Mr. E. G. Lewis,

Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Communications.

The agreement was for a new company to be formed in Nigeria, with a Nigerian majority on the Board, to take over the local assets and services of Gable and Wireless Ltd. in Nigeria.

The new company, to be called Nigerian External Telecommunications Ltd., will be invested by next January with an authorised capital of about £2 million, financed jointly by the Federal Government and Cable and Wireless, in a proportion of 50/o to 49/o. The initial term of partnership will be for five years.

The long-term objective was on all-Nigerian executive staff and to this end Cable and Wireless has undertaken to continue to train Nigerian staff at all levels and in all aspects of the new company's work, said Mr. Akinfosile.

Already a total of 19 Nigerians were at varying stages of training as engineers.

Sir John Macpherson said this agreement showed the way of the modern Commonwealth and it was entirely right that Nigeria should have the major share in the new develop-

ment.

The history of Cable and Wireless in Lagos dates back to 1880 when the first submarine cable was landed on Victoria Beach for the Africa Direct Cable Company.

# U. S. Justice Department Investigates Negro Church Bombings

WASHINGTON—The U.S. Justice Department report on the bombing and burning of Negro churches in Southwest Georgia has been turned over to President Kennedy for study, according to Pierre Salinger, the President's Press Secretary.

The President received the report when he returned to Washington on Monday after a weekend in Newport, Rhode Island. He discussed the church bombings and burnings with his brother, Attorney General Robert Kennedy, before returning to Washington.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation, a division of the Justice Department, and local authorities began inquiries to determine whether the buildings had been burned in an attempt to intimidate prospective voter registrants.

One Negro Church was destroyed in Leesburg, Georgia, and another in Saenger, Georgia, in a series of incidents apparently connected with a Negro vote registration campaign. Both churches had been used for voter registration meetings.

The campaign is being conducted by the student nonviolent coordinating committee which consists of white and Negro students and young adults from the northern and southern parts of the United States.

If the investigation produces evidence that the church bombings and burnings are linked with the vote registration campaign, the U.S. government will probably intervene on the Negroes' behalf under the civil rights act of 1960.

On previous occasions, both the President and the Attorney General have indicated that the Federal Government would not tolerate interference with citizens' right to vote.
