Army Entrance Examination For Potential Officers.

Applications are invited from persons wishing to be considered for entry into the Royal Military Academy, SANDHURST, or other United Kingdom Training Establishments with a view to becoming Regular or short Service Officers in the Royal Nigerian Army. The selection for Regular Commissions will be competitive, and candidates who fail to obtain a Regular commission may be offered a short Service Commission. A limited number of those obtaining a short Service Commission may be considered for a Regular Commission at later date.

CONDITIONS FOR NEXT ENTRY

Applicants must fulfil the following conditions:-

- (a) Age. (i) - For Regular Candidates - over 17 years 2 months and under 22 years of age as at 20 November 1961.
- (ii) - For short Service - under 25 years of age on 20 November 1961.
- (b) Medical. No physical disability and be at least 5 ft 2 inches in height.

- (c) Education. The General Certificate of Education, Teachers

Certificate, R.S.A. Stage II certificate or West African School II Certificate with a pass in the English Language and three other subjects. Applications will be accepted from candidates who have not yet been notified of the results of the last examination, provided a certificate is produced from their Headmaster stating that they have sat the last examination and, in his opinion, have a good chance of passing in the necessary Subjects. Should it be found subsequently that a candidate who has been accepted for military training, has failed his General Certificate, or the West African School Certificate, his training may be terminated.

EXAMINATION

With the exception of applicants who hold a University Degree all candidates will be required to pass a written examination. The written examination will be held on Tuesday 11 July and Wednesday 12 July 1961, at the following Centres:-

LAGOS KADUNA ENUGU IBADAN

Candidates will be examined in General Knowledge, English and Mathematics.

SELECTIONS AND MEDICAL BOARD

Candidates who have passed the written examination, and those who are exempt by possession of a University Degree, will be required to appear before a Force Selection Board at IBADAN or KADUNA followed by a Medical Examination at LAGOS or KADUNA.

TRAINING

Those candidates who are selected for training will be enlisted into the Royal Nigerian Army and will attend a 20 weeks Course at the Nigerian Military Training College, KADUNA. If successful, they will proceed to the U.K. for entry into the Royal Military Academy, SANDHURST, or other United Kingdom Training Establishments. On the successful completion of this training, cadets will be commissioned into the Royal Nigerian Army and will receive an initial salary of £768 a year.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

The names of applicants are required to reach Headquarters, Royal Nigerian Army, Lagos, not later than 9 June, 1961. Applicants must apply in writing and enclose a recommendation from a person in authority (e.g. District Officer, Minister of Religious Doctor, Solicitor or Officer in the Royal Nigerian Army not below the rank of Major). An application form, together with the examination syllabus, will then be sent to applicants.
