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New British Sweeper Combats Germ Menace

Vacuum Hospital



The combined efforts of two British firms and considerable research have produced a new vacuum sweeper which will play a major part in combating one of the biggest problems in hospitals—germ-laden dust.

The powerful cleaner works on the normal suction principle but all dust and small debris collected from ward and corridor floors passes between a battery of "death ray" ultra violet lights which means instant death to the germs which cause most cross-infection troubles in hospitals today.

The machine is claimed to have 100 percent germkilling efficiency. It can also be used as an air-purifying unit in wards and operating theatres.

Two nurses in a large London hospital are seen examining the new machine, which is light in weight and will ease the cleaning burden of hospital maids.

British Grants For The Gambia

LONDON — New British grants to the Gambia, recently approved under the Colonial Development and Welfare Acts, total over £27,000, it was announced recently in London.

£2,682 is to improve village water supplies and develop co-operatives and £3,522 is for haematological research in the Gambia.

They were grants approved in March, and bring the total of C. D. and W. grants during the first three months of 1962 to £3,846.—445.

Cured By British Leprosy Drug

SOUTH AFRICA — More than one thousand patients at the government leprosarium at Koeberg in Southern Rhodesia have been discharged in the past five years after medical staff used the British anti-leprosy drug "Dapsone", reports the Rhodesian Federal Ministry of Health.

Many were cured and the conditions of others had so improved that they could be treated as out-patients.

Ambrose Campbell To Sing "Ero Ya" On Thursday

LONDON—The name "Ambrose Campbell" is a familiar one to most Nigerians who have heard such records as "Iwa Dakere," "Ero Ya Ke Wa" and "Nigerian Koni Seti" which he made with his West African Rhythm Brothers. Listeners to the BBC programme "Calling Nigeria" on Thursday, May 31 can hear Ambrose Campbell singing some Nigerian folksongs to his own guitar accompaniment.

Ambrose Campbell is

Yoruba-born from Lagos. His father was a local Parish clergyman, and as a boy Ambrose was a good chorister. At first he did not think of making music his career, for on leaving school he joined the Nigerian Printing Press.

In 1940 he came to Britain to study printing, but did not go far with it. He still loved singing, and as Nigerians and other West Africans in Britain then were "thirsty" for their own kind of music,



The Future Of Aviation in Africa

LONDON—During the last ten years there has been a vast increase in the number of air routes operated both over and from Africa. Several African countries are now operating their own airlines and linking the African Continent with many European capitals.

The cost of these operations is unheigevably high and there are far more problems involved than most people realise.

What is the future of aviation in Africa likely to be? This is the main subject to be discussed in the BBC programme "African Forum" on Wednesday, May 23 when the guest speaker will be Sir Duncan Cumming K.B.E., C.B.

Sir Duncan was in the African Political Service from 1925 until 1951. During World War II he was

seconded to the Army and became Chief Civil Affairs Officer in the Middle East. In this capacity he was concerned with the disposal of the former Italian colonies which resulted in the independence of Libya and Somalia. In 1952 he was responsible for giving effect to the United Nations resolution on Eritrea. Since 1955 he has been with B.O.A.C., and is now B.O.A.C.'s adviser on African affairs.

He was formerly a member of the Boards of West African Airways Corporation and Ghana Airways. Sir Duncan's work takes him on frequent visits to Africa and his wide experience of aviation will therefore enable him to speak with great authority on the subject of Wednesday's BBC programme.
