Lecture On "Gari" In London

Nigerian Expert Addresses Food Congress

LONDON Fourteen hundred food experts from over 40 countries are attending the first International Congress on Food Science and Technology in London, recently heard a paper on "The Manufacture of Gari," given by a Nigerian scientist.

He is Mr. J. A. Akinrele, M.A. (Cantab), D.I.C. of the Federal Institute of Industrial Research at Ikeja, who said: "It is proving a most worth-while and well-timed congress, particularly in the field of shaping policies how to develop our own food resources, both agricultural and processing," said with Mr. R. A. Holgate also of the Mr. Akinrele.

"Some of the Indian delegates who have been developing ways of producing traditional foods in large scale food processing factories, have expressed great interest in my paper describing our own investigation into developing a mechanical system producing gari."

During the week before the congress, Mr. Akinrele visited research institutions in many parts of Britain to see some of the latest developments since his student days at Cambridge.

British Developments

"A visit to Torry research station at Aberdeen proved particularly rewarding," he commented in connection with launching a Nigerian stockfish industry. "They have begun work on trying to develop a heat dryer for fish, using the flue gases in trawlers, which is something we have been trying to do at the institute."

Mr. Akinrele explained that freezing methods would be too costly where heat drying at sea would provide Nigeria with a traditional dish from plentiful home resources.

"We should prefer to buy a heat dryer and adapt it, so the Torry experiments could be of the greatest help to us," he said.

Another subject of great importance to Nigeria was the production of protein from vegetables which Mr. Akinrele saw at Rothamsted Research Centre in Hertfordshire.

"Now that I have seen the advanced work at Rothamsted I am more than ever convinced that out vegetation could provide enough protein for all our population," Mr. Akinrele declared.

Next week he is going back to Cambridge to study the development in the low temperature research laboratory.

British Exports Are Growing Rapidly

KEY WORD IS "BUY BRITISH" GOODS

LONDON— "Export trade in Great Britain is growing rapidly," says a London Press Representative. The growth of British exports to Western Europe, which has been a feature of Britain's trade in the last few years, has continued during recent months. Board of Trade figures issued yesterday showed that in the three months, June-August, export to Western Europe increased by 4 per cent. over those in March-May, including an 8 per cent. increase in exports to Common Market countries.


