Chief Sec Makes Statement On Egyptian Universities

A statement by the Acting Chief Secretary to the Government (Mr. H. F. Marshall) states that it has come to the notice of Government that scholarships to Universities in Egypt, including the UNIVERSITIES of Al Azhar, Fouad and Farouk, have been offered to Nigerians.

In order to assist those who might wish to take advantage of this offer enquiries have been made as to the conditions prevailing in these Universities and the value of the degrees and qualifications conferred by them. The information received shows that the University of Al Azhar does not confer degrees in modern subjects such as medicine, and that, in the case of other two Universities, SUCH DEGREES AND QUALIFICATIONS ARE NOT OF THE STANDARD REQUIRED FOR ENTRY INTO THE SENIOR SERVICE. NOR WILL HOLDERS OF THESE UNIVERSITIES BE QUALIFIED TO PRACTISE IN NIGERIA.

Princess Elizabeth Meets Truman

Oct. 31st 1951. Princess Elizabeth met President Truman in Washington this afternoon. She flew from Montreal to the United States capital accompanied by the Duke of Edinburgh. The British Royal Couple are paying a visit of two days to Washington at the invitation of the president. Twentyone guns fired a salute as the Princess stepped from her aircraft. She and the Duke were immediately greeted by the President and Mrs. Truman who taken introduced leading Government officials to the Royal Couple. A state driver through the streets of Washington then followed during which the Princess smilingly acknowledged the welcoming cheers of the thousand who thronged her route.

NEGRO ADVANCES TO BECOME ART DIRECTOR OF PUBLISHING HOUSE

Chicago, Illinois.—A Negro who had worked for 12 years with Chicago trade book publishing house has become its art director. Mr. Stewart W. Williams, who had worked the wilcox and Follett firm publishers from the time of their approval by its editors to final publication. He selects type faces, makes layouts, chooses artists, and approves color plates. Four books he designed are among 49 chosen as outstanding by a judging committee that considered 533 books submitted by publishers in the Middle West area of the United States.

Yellow Fever and Small Pox Vaccination and other Inoculations for Persons Intending to Travel by Air

Intending passengers by air from Nigeria to destinations outside Nigeria must carry valid International Certificates of Vaccination against Yellow Fever and Smallpox.

YELLOW FEVER

In the case of inoculation against Yellow Fever for the FIRST TIME, the passenger may not leave Nigeria until 10 DAYS have elapsed since the date of inoculation. Passengers being re-inoculated may leave Nigeria immediately thereafter, PROVIDED THAT evidence of an inoculation, given not more than FOUR YEARS previously, is produced to the Inoculating Officer. AND THAT he certifies on the new certificate that it is a valid re-inoculation.

Yellow Fever inoculations can only be given in certain medical stations on account of difficulties of transport, storage and administration.

They may be obtained in Lagos, Kano, Zaria, Jos, Kaduna, Yola, Maiduguri, Sokoto, Gusu, Borin, Minna, Josdon Post Harcourt, Enugu, Warri, Calabar, Forcados, Victoria.

Yellow Fever inoculations of persons in the Lagos area will be given in the PATHOLOGY DEPT., BROAD STREET, LAGOS, EACH SATURDAY MORNING AT 09.00 hours. Only those persons will be inoculated who have, by letter or telephone, arranged for their inoculations with the Pathologist, Lagos (Tel. Lagos 332) at least 24 hours, before the time of inoculation.

SMALLPOX

Vaccination against smallpox should be performed at least one week prior to departure, as the second part of the International Certificate requires that the vaccination site should be inspected by the Vaccinating Officer on the 5th-7th day after vaccination. The certificate is not valid for more than 3 years from the date of issue.

In the case of re-vaccination, the passengers should report to the Vaccinating Officer on the 2nd day after vaccination.

Vaccinations in the Lagos area are performed at the HEALTH OFFICE, BROAD STREET, LAGOS, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 12 noon daily, (except Sunday, and at the PORT HEALTH OFFICE, Lagos, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. daily (except Sunday).

OTHER INOCULATIONS

Inoculations against Cholera, Typhus and Plague may be obtained by request to the Pathologist in Pathology Department, Lagos (Tel. Lagos 332) or by application to any Senior Medical Officer.
