Yellow Fever and Small Pox Vaccination and other Inoculations for Persons Intending to Travel by Air

Intending passengers by air from Nigeria to destinations outside Nigeria must carry valid International Certificates of Vaccination against Yellow Fever and Smallpox.

YELLOW FEVER

In the case of inoculation against Yellow Fever for the FIRST TIME, the passenger may not leave Nigeria until 10 DAYS have passed since the date of inoculation. Passengers re-inoculated may leave Nigeria immediately thereafter, PROVIDED THAT evidence of such an inoculation, given not more than FOUR YEARS previously, is produced to the Inoculating Officer, AND THAT he certifies on the new certificate that it is a valid re-inoculation.

Yellow Fever inoculations can only be given in certain medical stations on account of difficulties of transport, storage and administration.

They may be obtained in: Lago, Kano, Zaria, Jos, Kaduna, Yola, Maiduguri, Sokoto, Gusau, Borin, Minna, Ilorin, Port Harcourt, Enugu, Warri, Calabar, Forcados, Victoria.

Yellow Fever inoculations of persons in the Lagos area will only be given in the PATHOLOGY DEPT., BROAD STREET, LAGOS, EACH STUDY DAY, DURING ALL 0900 hours. Only those persons who will be inoculated, who have, by letter or telephone, arranged for their inoculations with the Pathologist, Lagos (Tel. Lagos 332) at least 24 hour, before the time of inoculation.

SMALLPOX

Vaccination against smallpox should be performed at least one week prior to departure, as the second part of the International Certificate requires that the vaccination site should be inspected by the Vaccinating Officer on the 5th-7th day after vaccination. The certificate is not valid for more than 3 years from the date of issue.

In the case of re-vaccination, the passengers should report to the Vaccinating Officer on the 5th day after vaccination.

Vaccinations in the Lagos area are performed at the HEALTH OFFICE, BROAD STREET, LAGOS, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 12 noon daily, (except Sunday), and at the PORT HEALTH OFFICE, Lagos, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. daily (except Sunday).

OTHER INOCULATIONS

Inoculations against Cholera, Typhus and Plague may be obtained by request to the Pathologist in Pathology Department, Lagos (Tel. Lagos 332) or by application to any Senior Medical Officer.
