

PERMANENT PORT PASSES

APAPA QUAY, CUSTOMS QUAY

The Public are hereby notified that all Permanent Passes (B1 &c) authorising holders to enter any or all the Authority's quays at Lagos, will cease to be valid after 31st December, 1961.

New passes, which will be of a different colour, will be available on or after 15th November, 1961, by completing and submitting an application form, together with two passport size photographs, to the Dock Superintendent at Apapa Quay or at Customs Quay, from whom application forms may be obtained.

Permanent Port Passes will only be issued to those persons whose business or duty necessitates their frequent entry into the Port Areas (s) concerned. Where there is doubt, applicants may be called upon to supply proof of their need for frequent entry to the Port Area (s).

Persons requiring a pass to enter more than one quay need only make one application upon which, if the application is approved, the necessary Permanent Port Pass permitting the holder to enter the required area (s) will be issued.

Applications will only be accepted from employers on behalf of their employees and passes will be issued to the employers for handing to their staff. Individual applications from employees will not be accepted neither will passes be handed to employees.

Employers are reminded that passes issued to their staff are to be returned to the Authority when such staff leave their services or their duties cease to warrant regular entry into the Port Area (s).




