EIGHT NEGROES ON JURY TO HEAR DUBOIS CASE

WASHINGTON—Twelve men and women were chosen last week as jurors for the trial of Dr. W. E. B. DuBois and four other directors and officers of the Peace Information Centre who are charged with failure to register under the Foreign Agents Registration Act. The panel of jurors, which convened on (November 13) was composed of eight Negroes and four white persons. They were selected from a panel of more than 125 persons from all walks of life.

Selection of jurors took place in the southern part of Federal judge Matthew F. McGowan. The selection, opened with a preliminary statement by prosecuting U.S. Attorney, outlining charges against the Peace Information Centre, and by defendants.

The prosecution then proceeded to address questions to prospective jurors. Defense attorneys, after a recess, also asked jurors a series of questions. Both sets of questions were designed to eliminate any jurors hostile to either case for defense or prosecution.

The Attorney asked jurors such questions as: "Have you ever opposed Federal Anti-Poll Tax Act, Federal Fair Employment Act, and Federal Anti-Lynching Act." They asked prospective jurors if they sympathized with racial discrimination against Negroes in housing, transportation, employment and other fields. The next set of questions asked if relatives in United States armed forces. Eighteen persons replied in affirmative. Those persons were then asked if their relationships would in any way prejudice their verdict. None replied in affirmative.
