Directors' Report ON THE AFFAIRS OF THE BANK

Your Directors have the pleasure to present to you the annual accounts for the year ended the 30th day of June, 1960. The year has been rather eventful for the Nigerian Banking World and for the Development of a Money Market in the country. The first is the introduction of Treasury Bills through which the Government borrows money from the public. Since the inception of this system of Government borrowing, the Central Bank has issued Treasury Bills on several occasions and at a total of many millions of pounds sterling. The rate of interest paid by Government has so far varied between 4% 1/2% and 5 1/16% as against the medium Bank Deposit rate of 2%. The Treasury Bills are issued in units of £1,000. This has had the effect of attracting Bank Deposits to Government loans and as such the Banks especially the African Banks with limited resources have lost a very considerable amount of customers deposit, attracted away by the Government borrowings. Shareholders will notice the reduction in the amount of the total of our resources and this is greatly due to the above reasons. Secondly the big European Banks have of late been opening branches all over the country at even remote places, this is a kind of competition which affects very adversely the African Banks. These big European Banks with their enormous resources created more confidence in our local Depositors despite a feeling of national sentiments. Let us hope however that with the arrival of independence the African Banking Institutions will be able to hold their own in face of severe competition which lie ahead. We your Directors will most certainly do all that is humanly possible to hold our own and to make progress but we must request your co-operation and assistance. We are now an independent sovereign state and we look forward to each and every one of us contributing to the progress and greatness of our country more so in the economic and financial field. The greatest contribution is by encouraging the saving of itself and savings.

A politically independent country with no economic independence is still in the same throes of colonialism. Now turning to our Balance Sheet the figures for the year 1960 are still encouraging though we would like to see it higher. When compared with the 1956 £7,321,041, 1957 £10,551,931, 1958 £12,119,530 and 1959 at £16,070,916 the result at 1960 is not wholly discouraging. During the year we have opened branches of the Bank at Oyo and Asaba and we still have plans for further expansions by opening new branches in both the Western and Eastern Regions.

Scholarships--In our last report we mentioned the question of Scholarships to deserving employees. The two we have in the London Office are doing well. We have added another one making three in the London Office and a fourth will shortly be leaving for the United Kingdom. We may mention that one of the big Banks of the United Kingdom, the National Provincial Bank Ltd, has agreed to help us in training our boys to give them a wider scope for a period of six months at any stage of their training. This gesture of goodwill from a big English Bank we highly appreciate and are grateful for same.

Capital Increase--We have now reached a stage in our development at which our Capital must be appreciably increased. Competition in the Banking World of Nigeria is going to get keener and keener which will mean the survival of the fittest. We must not deceive ourselves that because we are an indigenous bank we will be in a favourable position. Today we have a bank like the Bank of America the biggest and wealthiest Bank in the world and whose resources are worth billions of pounds in sterling. Another big American Bank is due out, the Chase Manhattan Bank of New York, and we have reasons to believe that many big foreign enterprises are still coming into the financial field of a sovereign independent Nigeria.

Our Capital today is around £1,200,000 of which £1,000,000 is Western Region Marketing Board Contribution by way of Preference Shares and the balance made up of equity shares by way of subscriptions and bonus shares after 27 years of our existence.

We have therefore come to a conclusion that we must have more capital otherwise we shall only have a poor chance of competing against mighty odds and we think the only people that can help us is the Western Region Marketing Board.

We extend our thanks to all our patrons, shareholders and our loyal staffs.
