

FACTS AND FIGURES

**THE MOHAMMEDAN CRISIS GIVEN
A DECENT BURIAL.**

End of the Massacre!

The Eko Quedlin and the Mohammedan Quarrels—
these are the two cities that for many years past have been
improving the progress of this Town and are largely
responsible for domestic and social as well as political
welfare in this part of our great dependency. As such, it is
an occasion of no little importance when on Thursday the
2nd day of March (1924) a burial—decent and legal if not
military (for politicians lined up the products of the Court)—

—was given one of these critics.
A fight is never settled until it is settled well; and, that
the decision of Sir Redrick was der Mullen has dropped
the veil closing up the final scene of the Mohammedan
Quarrel is a fact which goes without saying unless an
appeal is lodged by the defendants who has not come to
our knowledge as we write—and even then a straight road
to a final close-up is definitely and clearly marked.

"It has been made plain to both," says His Excellency
Sir Hugh Clifford in his Address to the Legislative Council,
"that this is a matter which concerns only those Mohammedans
who are residents in Lagos, and that any settlement
that may be reached must be achieved by mutual arrangement
and, best without any interference by the Government,
whose sole interest in this regrettable dispute is the
maintenance of law and order. Litigation arising out of
this dispute has now been begun in the Supreme Court."

The law is no rescuer of persons and we are gratified
that feelings of satisfaction at the decision of the C.C.C. are
being expressed by the larger section of the community.

We sincerely hope the small group of dissatisfied
ministers will rest in peace. The table has now turned and
at long last the law has taken its course. The axes of God
grind slowly but they grind exceedingly small. Who of us
is not surprised at the turn things have taken especially
when we recollect the troubles taken by Hon J. E. Ejecton
Shimpie and Mr. Herbert Macaulay to effect a mutual
settlement without success. The idea was commonly
exp'osed that one side could be defeated one side is
especially favoured by . . . and what not but we are
highly gratified that this shall have to be knocked out of
some brains these days. The magistrate is now ended
and the doctrine of one side being amenable is, though
their cause be wrong, fatal flat like Dagon before the Arch
of the Lord!!!

You can fool some people all the time; you can fool
all the people for some time; but you cannot fool all the


