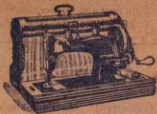

FACTS AND FIGURES
THE MOHAMMEDAN CRISIS GIVEN
A DECENT BURIAL.

End of the Masquerade!

The Ekko Question and the Mohammedan Quarrels—these are the two crises that for many years past have been keeping the progress of this town and are largely responsible for disquietude and social as well as political unrest in this part of our great dependency. As such, it is an occasion not little importance when on Thursday the 29th day of March 1921, a forward—decent and liberal if not *audacious* few proceedings, based on the precepts of the Court—was given one of these crises.

A fight is never settled until it is settled well; and, that the decision of Sir Frederick Van der Meulen has dropped the veil, casting up the final score of the Mohammedan Quarrels is a fact which goes without saying, unless an appeal is lodged by the defendants which has not come to our knowledge as we write—and even then a straight road to a final closing is definitely and clearly marked.

"It has been made plain to both," says His Excellency Sir Hugh Clifford in the Address to the Legislative Council, "that this is a matter which concerns only those Mohammedans who are resident in Lagos, and that any settlement that may be reached must be achieved by mutual arrangement, but without any interference by the Government, whose sole interest in this regrettable dispute is the maintenance of law and order. Legislation arising out of this dispute has now been begun in the Supreme Court." The law is no respecter of persons and we are gratified that feelings of satisfaction at the decision of the Court are being expressed by the larger section of the community.

We sincerely hope the small group of dissatisfied minority will rest in peace. The cable has now terminated at long last, but the blow has taken its course. The area of God's ground slowly but they grind exceedingly small. When of us it not surprised at the turn things have taken especially when we recollect the troubles taken by the Hon. J. Egerton Smythe and Mr. Herbert Mendeney to effect a mutual settlement without success. The idea was commonly expressed that one side cannot be defeated one side is especially favoured by . . . and what not but we are highly gratified that this shall have to be knocked out of some brains these days. The masquerade is now ended and the doctrine of one side being *amercy-mercly*, though their cause be wrong, falls flat like the Dragon before the Arch of the Lord!!!
