Sir,

We very much regret to observe the rather inconsiderable agitation that is being made by the Planters Union of Agege advocating the closing down of the Araromi Market and take this opportunity to respectfully submit this as a strong protest against the desire. The Araromi Market since it was started has at the suggestion of the Planters Union been changed to a day quite apart from the Agege Market day to avoid a clash and to afford the latter Market every scope for progress and if it has failed to achieve the expectations of its enthusiasts, the reason for the failure must be sought for elsewhere and the Araromi Market not blamed thereof.

2. We beg to state that the necessity for the Araromi Market is evinced by the fact that the district being an important centre of planting operations, much of the perishables must perish or deteriorate in quality and value and lose their refreshness and nourishing properties if kept to be disposed off only at the Agege Market. Hence the necessity for other intermediary markets such as the Araromi and Ayobo Markets for disposing of fruits and vegetables ripe and mature enough for disposal and consumption before the Agege Market day.

3. We would also state that we are quite prepared to still alter the day of holding the Araromi Market to any other day that the Government might consider advisable in order to afford every possible facility and avenue to the Agege Market. To close down the market however would entail much hardship and loss particularly to farmers or planters in the hinterland: farms who now find the Araromi and Ayobo Markets a great convenience. Besides it is respectfully submitted and will be readily conceded that these Market have acted even as feeders to the Agege Market in certain class of commodities which previously owing to the

distance of the Agege Market were not being previously brought down.

It is hoped that this prayer will be favourably considered.

" I am to suggest to you and the signatories
to the Resolution that, if they desire their
representations on any subject to be seriously
considered by the Government, they should

conclusion, I am to say that the idea that all
social and other improvements are only to be
brought about by the active interference of the
Government is not one which it is desirable to
entertain or to encourage; and that self-help is a
quality which might fittingly engage the attention
of local philanthropic opists. So far as His
Excellency is aware, nothing in the nature of
attempts to render social service to their less
fortunate and less instructed neighbours are
commonly made in Lagos by the ladies for whom
the signatories to the Resolution claim to speak."
