FACTS AND FIGURES

1921 CENSUS RETURNS.

How many of our children are being taught the facts and figures relative to the population of this vast dependency to say nothing of their crass ignorance of the general political Geography of British West Africa. The average school boy in Lagos knows more about the *British Isles*, *Dominion of Canada* etc. than he knew of Nigeria. In this direction the institution of the Government Civil Service Examinations is heartily welcome in so far as it enjoins a thorough knowledge of Nigeria and we cannot but be delighted in these days to see young folks studying from the *Nigeria Handbook*. As this book is studied only by those intending to enter the Government services there is still the necessity for the formulation of a plan by which school children would be made more informed about the country in which they live.

But we rather should stick to our subject for to-day which is "1921 Census Returns". We are greatly indebted to the *Nigeria Gazette* (31/1/24) in which the following among other details are published —

The above figures speak for themselves. In the Southern Province we had 8,351,845 Europeans according to the census of 1921 so that taking that number from 2,762 as recorded above we have 8,349 increase in the European population in the Southern Province within the space of ten years. In the Northern Province the European population was formerly estimated to be 847 which taken from 1,127 (as above) leaves 280 as the increase of European population.
