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GOVERNMENT PRESS 1928.

THE Annual Report of the Government Printing Department for the year 1928 is an interesting document for every printer in this part of the world. It contains a detailed statement of the number of Departmental Forms, Books, etc., supplied and brought to account during the year 1928.

The decrease in the output of forms and miscellaneous items was more than compensated for by the increase in books, and the value of work done and brought to account during 1928 shows an increase of nearly £400; (£37,294. 6. 10d against £36,904. 11. 5d. in 1927) for 6,460,307 Departmental Forms, 4,412 Receipt Books, 179,512 Pamphlets including Gazettes and supplements, 58,836 Books and Ledgers, 3755 General Orders, Staff List Hand Book Civil Service List, 1587 Blue Books and Estimates, 13491 Annual Reports and Sessional Papers, 375626 Miscellaneous. These quantities were printed off 3112 Forms of which 1802 were kept standing.

The efficiency of the staff both European and African is all that could be desired. It is doubtful whether we could find anything approaching it in any part of British West Africa or rather in the whole of Africa, with the possible exception of Egypt and Cape Colony.

This Department has proved a beneficial institution to the country. Apart from revenue producing considerations, it has assisted the progress of our printing and book-binding trades in a way that reflects great credit upon the Government of Nigeria. This is testified to by the high class printing and book-binding regularly issued from the department and other private printing and book binding offices, the staffs of which have, in many cases, passed through it at one time or the other.

It is hoped the existing terms of apprenticeship in the department will be supplemented with one year's further instruction in some of the great printing establishments in England to enable deserving African cadets to obtain deeper insight into the different branches of the art of printing.

Mr. J. A. Blair, who succeeds Mr. De Boltz, is a capable and an experienced officer. We congratulate him upon his well-merited promotion.
