

Letters to "Eko Akete."

Sir,

Permit me to correct an error which occurred in your issue of the 21st July.

In an article written in Yoruba, a remark was made that Calabar women have been the cause of venereal diseases now rife in the colony. To say the least, it is the most unprovoked attack to have associated the name of Calabar with the women concerned.

However, I shall not be hard on the writer, as his article has prompted the performance of a duty long since deferred.

As time and space will not permit a minute history of the Calabar people, I shall indulge only in a very brief description of tribe.

The people of Duke Town, Creek Town, Henshaw Town, Old Town, Ikonedo, Ikobofong and Adiabo compose the tribe known as Efik tribe.

No people outside these towns have any right to claim Calabar as their native land.

We all know that for political convenience the great country of Nigeria is divided into the Western Province, with Lagos as the chief town; the central province with Warri as the head; and the Eastern province with Calabar as the principal town.

A glance through the map of Nigeria will show that they are more than thirty towns forming the Eastern province. Among these are Akunakuna and Atam, the native land of the women in William and Porto Novo Streets.

There are many Yoruba people here who could testify that the Atams are no more Calabar people than I am a West Indian.

Calabar women are not above a dozen in Lagos, and these have no marks to distinguish them from other West African tribes.

The Atams have their tribal marks, and a distinct language in which I do not understand a syllable.

Many of them here have never seen the land of Calabar since their birth.

It being their darling wish to be passed as Calabar women, they spare no pain in learning our language as soon as they arrive in the Colony.

It is rank folly that among themselves, and in the presence of a Calabar person they behave as Akuanakuna people, but before their customers every effort is made to drown their nationality.

Attempts have been made, with some success to oust them from Calabar.

The people at home will recoil with horror and indignation to hear that the people they are turning out of their Land are classed here as their very sisters.

If their being under Calabar for political purpose entitle them to the name, then all in Nigeria are Lagosians.

It is true that the ancient town of Calabar is now humiliated, but the people will not thank any one who aims at wounding their national pride.

Hoping that my feeble efforts will serve as a useful guide for future references, and thanking you for space allowed.
