DADA ADESIGN BIN.

Merchant: dropped his foreign name "Moses" in after years; educated in St. Paul's (Broadstreet) School, Lagos, started life as Master Tailor; with the Motto "Business before Pleasure," came into prominence by his famous Singer Sewing Machine business; presented a donation of 120 guineas to his Church Bethel on attaining the age of 45, 1919; has published Annual Almanacs of African life (illustrated); lost his eldest son -y- in Sierra Leone (whither he had gone for further training) during the Influenza Epidemic 1918, visited Europe and America in company with Mr. R. A. T. A. Johnson of this country who played the part of "Private Secretary" to him, 1905.

Joined the great majority on Sunday 8th February, 1925. Aged 60 years—From Nigerian Who's Who.

FACTS AND FIGURES.

Sir Harry Johnston On An All-Black Republic.

MARCUS GARVEY'S IDEA SUPPORTED BY THE GREATEST EUROPEAN AUTHORITY ON AFRICA.

The following extracts appeared in the Afro-American (April 25, 1925):—

"*Look for a big Black Republic in Africa*."—London Evening Standard, January 7.—(Sir A. N. P.)—In an interview here recently, Sir Harry Johnston, the empire builder, who served our kith and kin, Ghana and Nigeria for Great Britain during his forty years in Africa, told a correspondent for the Chicago Daily News that he visioned a vast republic of the colored races (African) in part in the balance of world power, in the coming epoch, color which he envisions, white civilization will begin to perish and the heart of the dark

"I don't expect to see a black Africa in my time," said Sir Harry, who was 66. "However, it is entirely possible that Great Sahara may be one great black republic." *Print for U.S.A. at Rosenthal & Son.*—Many considerations go to indicate the eventual success of a black dominion throughout Africa. The deadly climate in the central portion of the Congo and the Cameroons—a climate absolutely fatal to whites, is one factor. The encouraging success of

Liberia in being able to maintain its identity is another. The visits desire for independence—the following title of color—"yet another"—Many of the Negro and Negroid tribes in Africa are fully capable of independence and unless their political instincts are depraved by the ingress of whites they should be able to take care of themselves. The African type at its best is a fine type of mankind."

Sir Harry is usually considered the greatest living authority on Africa. He went to the Congo in 1880, worked with Stanley. His scientific discoveries and researches have made him even more highly known. For two decades he collected fauna, flora, pathology and made a special study of its language. He is the author of the only available work in English on the Bantu tongues. After all said and done Marcus Garvey's dream of an African Republic is not as fantastic as some people have been trying to make it. It is not impossible if realization at present is larger, it very far to that of realization some day. The fact that no less an authority on Africa than Harry Johnston (see *African*) could envision the same idea is an evidence that it is nothing that should cause us alarm if we are not indifferent to facts. But also, some critics—aren't they fanatics?—have shouted themselves hoarse this side of the water, raising alarm over the idea of a Black Republic. Do these critics believe that the Negro is an **GOOD A MAN** as the European? We know not.
