

THE PASSING YEAR.

[BY MUMUNYEY.]

Just at this time, when the new year will soon dawn upon us it is wise to look back and survey what we have been doing during these 12 months that are ebbing out and know to what extent we have been or likely to be benefitted, and to what extent we have not, so as to be in a position to resolve whether we should continue on the same *modus operandi* or change our lines of action for the coming year. In such a review we are apt to discover, in some cases, where our actions have reacted against our very selves and may take this sort of discovery as lessons for our future guidance.

The whole world is slowly but steadily moving out of the chaotic atmosphere of the concomitants of the late war and one need not be a prophet to bespeak the messages of hope which the new year is likely to have in store for all and sundry.

Making a recollection of happenings in progressive Europe one finds that some incidents will furnish the coming generations with interesting and instructive reading. The final settlement of the Near Eastern Deadlock, the pacification of Irish Home Rule ambitions which takes the form of Free State Government, the Rhur situation, the Greco-Italian conflict; in Great Britain, the unemployment problem, the lamentable death of Mr. A. Boosey Law, the sensational Hord Murder in which three lives were involved—These are events that will no doubt go down in history.

In America, the land of Stars and Stripes, the regrettable death of President Harding, the sensational conviction of Hon. Marcus Garvey head of the U.N.I.A., the greatest Negro organisation in the world, the activities of citizens of the invincible empire of *Klux Klan*, the wholesale migration of Negroes from the South Northward, the Note of Warning received from France on the question of stupid actions of White Americans towards French Negroes in France, the continual campaigne on keeping the United States "dry" and many other incidents have contributed to make this year one of the most historical ones.

In Japan, the great earthquake of Tokyo and Yokohama which deals a serious blow to the Japanese Empire, an earthquake unprecedented in history; in India, the question of Indianisation of civil service etc., an indirect proclamation of the Munro Doctrine; in South Africa, the great struggle between the Nationalist and the dominant Parties on the question of whether South Africa should for or should not sever connection with Great Britain, the Kenya affairs in which the

Indians are actively engaged in fighting out their right to equality with Europeans—All these will furnish principal chapters in new world's political history.

Coming nearer home in West Africa, the general preparation for the forthcoming Empire Exhibition, the postponement of the Colonial Office visit after all preparations, the departure of Professor Faduma to America to study American school methods, the success of Hon. C. B. May to the Mayoral Chair of Freetown Sierra Leone, the solidarity displayed by the people of Gold Coast when making arrangements to receive the Under-Secretary; in the Liberian Republic, the re-election of President C. D. B. King, the completion of the gigantic college mansion in Monrovia undertaken by Rev. Brooks are events that should be noted.

In happy-go-lucky Lagos, the general political upbeaveth throughout the year, the consummation of the Franchise, a political elevation not previously attained or enjoyed by any Negro community throughout the length and breadth of Africa the unfortunate flaming into flames of the dying embers of Mohamedan Crisis occasioned by the death of Chief Imam Braimah, the birth of three local newspapers The Nigerian Spectator, The Nigerian Advocate and the Eleti-Ofe, an acuity of progress, the revolver shooting sensation within the precincts of the Law Court, a dastardly deed unheard of in local history, another tragic incident of the 11th instant when Mr J. M. Aribisala suddenly fell down dead inside the Law Court before Judge M. L. Tew while actively engaged in a civil action, the conviction of a Lagos Barrister, the lamentable failure of Lagos to send delegates to the Sierra Leone session of the Congress—these are incidents that one will remember vividly in the eve of New Year.

It is, as we have said, necessary to decide whether we should continue or change our lines of action for the coming year. Another question that stands prominently in the forefront is whether or not our leaders will bury their tomahawks and allow the past continuous fighting to sail away in the barque of the passing year and start the succeeding one with clean slates. There have been political quarrels for the past few months, as indeed there should be, occasioned by the Election. This is natural enough. But there is certainly no wisdom in persistent pursuit of the war-path if the interest and welfare of the country is really the common aim.

However let us hope that our leaders are quite alive to the interest and welfare of the country and will see their way to alter their lines of action, unite and present a solid front in matters of general interest—then and not till then things may take a turn for the better!!!
