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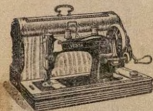

Happenings precedent and unprecedented have made their terrific or mild appearances as the case may be, but I must confine myself to an unprecedented happening, terrific in its tragedy, and so far as the person who met this tragedy, frightful to reason, and which shows the terrific power of human diabolical vengeance, one of the wearers of the white hair symbolical of supreme justice despatched within the very precincts of courts of justice. Imagine the terror of the populace of August 25th 1923, Saturday,

As they fled in

terrific routs

Each man stunned, staggered

and routed

By the cruel example of Fate,

This incident is probably unprecedented all the world over, and it is even certain that nothing like it has ever happened in a Court of Justice. Opinions differ as to the aftermath of this incident. Murder and suicide have been treated by Juries (under special circumstances) as proceeding from one of unsound mind i. e. without malice aforethought, for the madman may be under the impression that he is breaking a jar or so. But, murder without malice aforethought is manslaughter which is not usually accompanied by sentence of death. Murder with malice aforethought is when a man has in his mind to kill his offender as soon as opportunity offers, in order to revenge himself on the man, he thinks has wronged him so that we see that murder has "revenge" for its origin and manslaughter "dispute" for its origin. A suicide or murderer was at one time disallowed to be buried on consecrated ground, but would seem that the natural conscience of man revolted later against the idea hence before 1887 the English Jury were fond of adding to their verdict a rider "suicide (or murder as the case may be) while of unsound mind." This brought about the passing by Parliament of the "Interments Act 1882 that rescinded the custom of burying the suicide (or murderer or both) on unconsecrated ground." In the midst of life we are in death, and who knows what next? The atmosphere after this tragic incident was very foreboding. An evil inspiration travelled like wild fire through the hitherto sacred regions of the hearts of Lagosians. But this

cruel inspiration was innocently smothered by the Providence through His word, and through the sane opinions expressed by the Press.

May the good Lord save us in Lagos, and bless every effort for the true interpretation of the Law among us.

What a pity.

VAUGHAN, WILSON JAMES

Merchant (Ironmongery) born 1866, educated at Christ Church Faj, and at the C.M.S. Grammar School 1880; lost his father 1893; is a Deacon of his Church (Ebenezer Native Baptist) is a gifted poet; published *The Dynamoite* in honour of his 40th birthday, 1915, chief of his poems include *Agogo Eleka* published in our language, 1908, *The Young Widow*, *The Christian Warfare*; has dominated many a charitable movement, died at sea on his return from England with his brother Mr. B. C. Vaughan to Lagos, and was buried in Gambia October 1923.

THE NIGERIAN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ELECTION.

We are bound to take a lively interest in the new regime inaugurated by the election of three members to form the new Legislative Council of Nigeria brought about by the initiative of the National Congress of British West Africa. Whatever may be said to the contrary, it is a matter of history, that this concession is a partial reply of government to what may be regarded as the main plank of the Congress Programme of privileges sought for from government by the London Delegation of the Congress in 1920.

Our sister Colony of Nigeria took the lead and was the first to announce the change of policy. It is therefore a matter of anxious interest to watch at a distance how she has fared and what she has made of her privilege. It is greatly to be deplored that there has been for a long while, a state of better dissention, sometimes tending to personal animosities, amongst those who should be leaders of the people. In our judgment this has been mainly due to a lack of that public spirit which should recognize every one in the community, however humble in station, as an integral part of the whole and treated with becoming decorum and due consideration. There seems to exist a sort of despotic conservatism which has entirely stood in the way of the rich helping the poor and the poor loving the rich as in the old days of Rome. The pity has been, that such an unwholesome attitude has been allowed to grow in intensity to the extent that it has lent itself to acts of lawlessness and bitter revenge, a condition of affairs which has quite removed the political contest of that community away from the platform of a healthy legitimate election campaign, as obtains in civilized countries.

We are sincerely sorry for this and would appeal to every true lover of country in that community to see the reasonableness of burying the hatchet and rising above petty differences and such bitter animosities as may be gleaned exist from the severe and, we trust, exaggerated description of present condition by a section of the press, of the moral and intellectual stamina of the people in general of that otherwise most fortunate colony.

It is undeniable that the members of the National Democratic Party have won the confidence of the people. We are sorry that there should be any cause for any one to suggest that such an achievement has been secured through base and unworthy agencies. In our mind, it would not be enough to justify such allegations by just sweeping statements; but there is a moral responsibility on those who make them, to bring cogent facts in substantiation of their imputation, if they must be listened to by sensible persons. Whatever allowance, we grant should be made on the ground that the movement is new and a certain measure of incongruities must be allowed, we contend it should not take the form of indirect practicality the whole community with acts of miscreancy and villainy. We have read with severe pain the withering strictures of our contemporary the *Nigerian Spectator*, and have been wondering what wave of diabolism has recently surfeited the people, if those pronouncements are something more than the imaginary.

We are forced to ask, have the Christian Churches their influence? Can it be true that such a well-to-do wholesale degeneracy could so soon have affected the people for whom we had along treasured high regard and affectionate confidence? We cannot imagine even a moment, that any one could be so insensible, whatever the cause may be, as to forget what serious and baneful consequences may follow such allegations as have been made against a large section of the community.

Is it possible that a distinguished personage in the Oluwa a princely great-heart, whom we have been to venerate and love could lend his lead to followers who have been described as lawless, diabolical, and unworthy? We have noticed that the three named candidates from the National Democratic Party were nominated by the White Cap Chiefs.

Are not these men true and loyal to government? Are they not respected by all?
